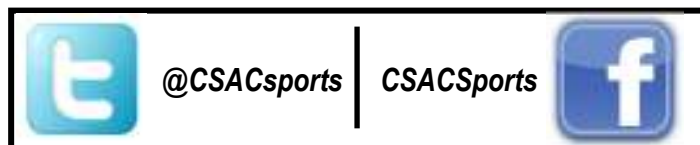

# CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Baptist Bible Defenders (0-8, 0-4 CSAC)



The Lady Defenders started off the second half of the season with back to back to back losses. On Monday, the team took a hit from non-conference opponent, Susquehanna, as the Crusaders cruised to a 55-20 win. Cabrini had no trouble with BBC on Wednesday, as they down the Lady Defenders 79-24. Things did not get much better on Saturday as BBC was dealt its second straight conference road loss, falling 71-31 to Immaculata. This week the Lady Defenders have three more games, all against conference foes. Monday will see the Lady Defenders travel to Marywood. Back at home on Wednesday, BBC will take on long time rival Cairn at 7 pm, and the team will finish off the week on the road at Neumann.

## Cabrini Cavaliers (10-3, 5-0 CSAC)



Cabrini improved to 5-0 in the CSAC and 10-3 overall with a pair of wins last week. Sophomore **Meghan Martin** scored a career high 16 points in 16 minutes in the Cavaliers' 79-24 win over Baptist Bible on Wednesday. On Saturday, junior **Amber Keys** matched Martin with 16 points, leading five players with at least eight points each in a 75-48 win over Centenary. The Blue and White will face a tough week, as it steps out of league play tonight to host Delaware Valley College before hosting Rosemont on Saturday and traveling to Keystone on Saturday.

## Cairn Highlanders (0-8, 0-4 CSAC)



The young guard tandem of sophomore **Amie Eppolito** and freshman **Elizabeth Joy Hartzler** combined to score 26 of the Highlanders 32 points on the night versus Stevens. **Eppolito** finished one rebound shy of a double-double against CSAC rival Notre Dame, contributing 13 points and nine boards. **Eppolito** and **EJ Hartzler** dished three assists apiece while **Brigid Shehan** and **Emily Tambussi** hauled in 11 caroms each in the narrow four-point loss. Cairn hits the road for its next three contests at CSAC foes Cedar Crest (Monday), Baptist Bible (Wednesday) and Centenary (Saturday).

## Cedar Crest Falcons (1-11, 0-5 CSAC)



The Falcons dropped two conference games this week, first to Marywood 73-27, then Gwynedd-Mercy 93-45. For the Falcons, senior **Amber Wehry** finished the week with 23 points and 14 rebounds, while junior **Breonna Lewis** finished with 19 points and 16 rebounds. The Falcons will host Cairn University on Monday night in their 2014 home opener.

## Centenary Cyclones (4-8, 2-2 CSAC)



Centenary saw its record evened at 2-2 in CSAC play following losses to Gwynedd Mercy and Cabrini last week. Freshman forward **Mallory George** recorded a 19-point, 13-rebound double-double, her third of the year, against the Griffins. Centenary shot 41 percent and outrebounded GMU 47-34, but was hurt by 30 turnovers. **George** and fellow rookie **Jessie Sharr** paced the Cyclones with nine points apiece versus Cabrini. For the first time during her 12-game career, **George** was held below 13 points. The Cyclones visit Neumann on Monday before hosting Keystone and Cairn later in the week.

## Gwynedd Mercy Griffins (6-8, 3-2 CSAC)



Gwynedd Mercy fell at Catholic, 84-72, Monday evening despite a 24 point performance from senior **Lauren Smith**. **Smith** was 7-of-16 from the floor including a 4-for-8 performance from downtown. Senior **Nicole Dougherty** added 11 while juniors **Kelsey Yori** and **Natasha Matthews** each chipped in 10 apiece. The Griffins hit the road again Wednesday traveling to Centenary and came away with a 65-55 CSAC victory. **Dougherty** led all scorers with a game-high 20 points. **Jordan Dominic** also finished in double figures, netting 10 points. **Matthews** led the Griffins on the boards, grabbing 10 of her own. GM defeated Cedar Crest, 93-45, Saturday afternoon to win their third-straight CSAC game. **Dougherty** netted 20 points for the second game in a row. **Smith** added 12 points. Gwynedd also saw 14 different players reach the scoring column with **Yori** (11) and **Matthews** (10) hitting double figures. The Griffins return back to action on Monday hosting Keystone. Tip-off is scheduled for 6 p.m. as part of a CSAC doubleheader with the men.

# CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Immaculata Mighty Macs (9-3, 5-0 CSAC)



Immaculata continued its undefeated streak in CSAC play and stayed perfect on its home court this season after rolling to two wins last week against Notre Dame (84-24) and Baptist Bible (71-31). **Sara Smith** led the team in scoring for the week averaging 13.5 points per game. **Lindsay Cras** paced the Mighty Macs against the Gators with 15 points, while **Alison Zimny** had a team-best 16 points opposite the Defenders. **Mackie Fitzgerald** handed out 12 assists in the two games, including a career-high eight helpers against Notre Dame. Immaculata plays Rowan in non-conference action in its only contest of the upcoming week.

## Keystone Giants (9-3, 3-0 CSAC)



The Giants edged Wells College, 77-75, on Tuesday evening led by 20 points from **Ashley Evans** and a double-double on 11 points and a game-high 15 rebounds by **Chantel Blake**. **Alyssa Cuomo** scored 17 points, **Jazmyn Robinson** scored 14 points, and **Jerica Rode** contributed 11 points in the win. Keystone had its winning streak snapped at three games on Thursday night at Eastern University defeated the Giants 73-64. **Robinson** led five Keystone players in double-figures with 15 points and five assists while **Blake** and **Evans** netted 13 points apiece. **Rode** tallied 11 points while **Cuomo** contributed 10 points in the loss. The Giants will play three CSAC contests this week visiting Gwynedd Mercy and Centenary on Monday and Wednesday, respectively before hosting Cabrini on Saturday afternoon.

## Marywood Pacers (9-4, 4-1 CSAC)



Marywood went 2-1 on the week with wins over King's and Cedar Crest. The Pacers ended a three-game losing streak with a 77-67 triumph at King's. The Pacers jolted to a 22-point lead at the break before holding off the Monarchs in the second half. **Brittany Mang** led five Pacers in double figures with 15 points. Ahead 16-14 through the first eight minutes, Marywood held the Falcons to just two field goals the rest of the way in a 73-27 win over Cedar Crest. **Carly Leitzel** scored 10. The Pacers dropped its first CSAC game of the season in a 64-56 loss to Neumann on Saturday. **Ashley Murray** and **Morgann Haduck** scored 15 and 14 points, respectively. Marywood hosts Baptist Bible Monday before traveling to Notre Dame.

## Neumann Knights (6-6, 3-2 CSAC)



Neumann evened its record with two conference wins. Neumann hosted Rosemont on Wednesday and came away with a 79-69 win. **Erica Marvel** led the Knights with 19 points. **Lauren Walker** netted 15 points. **Jessica Schlesman** notched 11 and **Colleen Hinde** added 10. **JoHanna Metzger** pulled down 16 boards and had four blocks. The Knights then traveled to Marywood and handed the Pacers their first conference loss of the year, 64-56. **Marvel** led the Knights with 20 points, including four baskets from beyond the arc, to lead the Knights. **Metzger** added 15 points. **Schlesman** pulled down 10 boards. Neumann will be on the court for three CSAC games this week, beginning with Centenary at home on Monday. The Knights will then travel to Notre Dame Wednesday before returning home to host Baptist Bible Saturday.

## Notre Dame Gators (1-12, 1-4 CSAC)



The basketball team claimed its first win of the season with a 32-28 victory over CSAC rival Cairn University on Saturday. The Gators used a strong defensive effort as they posted 15 steals in the contest and forced a season high 37 turnovers. The team also took advantage of an 11 minute stretch in the second half where the Gators allowed just three points. Notre Dame was led by **Kam Medina**, who led all players with 17 points and also finished with five steals. **Erika Deppenschmidt** added eight points while **Stephanie Miller** chipped into the defensive effort with a career high five steals. **Marylu Ortiz** paced the squad with 11 rebounds. On Wednesday, Notre Dame dropped a contest to Immaculata University 84-24. This week the squad will host CSAC powers Neumann Wednesday night and Marywood on Saturday.

## Rosemont Ravens (3-9, 1-3 CSAC)



The Neumann Knights foiled a late comeback attempt at Aston as the Ravens fell 76-66 Wednesday. On Saturday, a strong DeSales team powered over Rosemont, 96-74 in a non-conference match-up. In the game **Liz Coyne** scored 25 with 9 boards. The game scheduled for Monday vs. PSU-Berks has been rescheduled for 2/9.
