CSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ROSEMONT COLLEGE

Liz Coyne had perhaps her strongest week of the season, leading the Ravens to their third straight win. On Monday, Coyne played only 26 minutes, but scored 20 points. On Wednesday, in Rosemont's overtime win over Neumann, Coyne poured in 29 points and a career-high 23 rebounds. It was Coyne's 13th double-double in 16 games, ranking her in the top three in the NCAA in that category.

CSAC HONOR ROLL

JESS SCHLESMAN, NEUMANN UNIVERSITY

Schlesman had a career high in points scoring 33 against Gwynedd Mercy University. She also converted 18-of-21 free throws to help her team win. Her stats for the game were 33 points, eight rebounds, three assists and two steals. She then had 20 points, seven rebounds, three assists and one steal in a 75-68 overtime loss at Rosemont. In three CSAC games for the week, she averaged 18 points, six rebounds, three assists and two steals, helping her team with a 2-1 conference record.

ASHLEY MURRAY, MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY
Jr. - G - Dunmore, Pa.

Murray scored 41 points in a 72-65 come-from-behind victory over Gwynedd Mercy. Murray broke a 30-year old school record, thanks to a 12-for-24 shooting performance. Murray also led the team with seven rebounds. For the week, she hit eight 3-pointers on 17 tries for (47%). Murray also scored nine points in a loss at Cabrini earlier in the week. She leads the Pacers with 13.4 points per game.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Baptist Bible Defenders (1-12, 1-8 CSAC)



The Lady Defenders went 0-2 on the week as they fell to both Cedar Crest College and Immaculata University. On Wednesday night, BBC fell on the road to the Falcons, 53-32. Despite **Maeghin Mueller's** 14 points and 11 boards, the Lady Defenders could not produce enough offense to earn their second win of the season. Hosting the Mighty Macs at home on Saturday, BBC had no answer for the balanced offense of the CSAC top team. BBC will have two games this week as they host Cabrini College on Wednesday and then take to the road, battling Notre Dame (MD) on Saturday.

Cabrini Cavaliers (14-4, 8-1 CSAC)



The Cavaliers bounced back from its first conference loss with a pair of CSAC wins last week. Senior **Brittany Sandone** and juniors **Amber Keys** and **Megan Decker** combined for 51 points in Cabrini's 81-54 win over Marywood on Monday. **Sandone** then hit 4-8 from three point range, scoring a game-high 20 points in a 66-48 win at Centenary. Cabrini will continue its four game road, visiting Baptist Bible on Wednesday and Marywood on Saturday.

Cairn Highlanders (1-13, 1-9 CSAC)



Cairn suffered against Rosemont last Monday with a final score of 92-46. However, the Highlanders were able to pull out their first win of the season against Notre Dame on Thursday night. **E.J. Hartzler** led in scoring for the night recording 13 points and **Amie Eppolito** closely followed with 12 points, 8 rebounds, and 5 assists. The Highlanders sought another win on Saturday facing fourth-place Neumann University but were defeated 86-43. **Eppolito** tallied a career high of 26 points along with 7 rebounds and 4 assists. This week the Lady Highlanders will take on Bryn Athlen College on Monday, Keystone College Wednesday and Trinity University on Saturday.

Cedar Crest Falcons (5-13, 3-7 CSAC)



The Falcons finished the week 2-1 overall and 2-1 in the CSAC with wins over Baptist Bible 53-32 and Notre Dame of Maryland 56-26 and the one loss coming against Keystone 74-57. Junior **Breonna Lewis** led the Falcons this week averaging a double-double with 16 points and 10.3 rebounds per game. Senior **Amber Wehry** had a successful week averaging 13.3 per game and grabbing 20 total rebounds.

Centenary Cyclones (6-11, 4-4 CSAC)



Centenary dropped its final non-league game, falling 75-69 at the College of New Rochelle on Thursday. The Cyclones also were defeated by Cabrini at home 66-48. Freshman forward **Mallory George** produced a pair of double-doubles during the week, collecting 24 points and 10 rebounds at CNR and recording an 18-point, 10-rebound performance against the Cavaliers. **George's** 24 points were the most by a Cyclone since 2012. All 10 of her rebounds versus CNR came on the offensive end. Senior **Klarissa Perry** averaged 19.5 points and 9.5 boards in two games to aid the Cyclones. Sophomore **Ally Fugnitti** drained a trio of three-pointers during the week and has now made at least one triple in nine-straight games.

Gwynedd Mercy Griffins (8-10, 5-4 CSAC)



The Griffins hit the road this week for three games. In Monday's close 77-74 loss at Neumann, senior **Lauren Smith** had 21 points, but a last-second shot did not fall in the three-point defeat. Wednesday saw the Griffins head to Marywood, where the Pacers erased a 13-point second-half deficit to pull out a 72-65 win. Junior **Kelsey Yori** led four players in double figures. Finally on Saturday, GM took on Keystone and came away with a big 85-74 victory. **Yori** (17 points) led a balanced attack that saw five players reach double digits.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Immaculata Mighty Macs (13-4, 8-0 CSAC)



Immaculata reached the mid-way point in its CSAC schedule with a perfect 8-0 mark. It marks the best PAC/CSAC start in program history for the Mighty Macs, who were 3-1 last week with victories against Notre Dame, Keystone and Baptist Bible. Immaculata's only loss was a 60-53 setback to Haverford, who was among others receiving votes in the latest USA Today Sports Division III Top 25 Coaches Poll. The loss snapped a six-game winning streak, and was the Mighty Macs' first home loss. **Sara Smith** led the squad averaging 12.0 points and 5.5 rebounds during the four games last week. **Smith** posted double figures in scoring in all three league games. **Brittany Merkle**, who averaged 10.3 points and 5.3 rebounds, paced the team with 19 points in its win against Keystone.

Keystone Giants (11-7, 5-4 CSAC)



Jazmyn Robinson became Keystone's all-time leader in assists in Monday night's 74-57 win over Cedar Crest after finishing with a game-high five helpers in the victory. **Aaliya Hayes** came off the bench to lead the Giants with 18 points while **Chantel Blake** added her fifth double-double of the season on 14 points and 10 rebounds in the win. Immaculata defeated Keystone 85-78 on Wednesday. **Hayes** again led the Giants with 18 points while **Robinson** (16), **Ashley Evans** (14), and **Blake** (11) also reached double-figures in the loss. In Saturday's 85-74 loss to Gwynedd Mercy, **Robinson** recorded game-highs of 27 points, eight assists, and five steals while **Hayes** added a double-double on 16 points and 12 rebounds. **Alyssa Cuomo** netted 17 points in the loss to the Griffins. Keystone will play a pair of road league games this week, visiting Cairn on Wednesday before traveling to Rosemont Saturday.

Marywood Pacers (12-5, 7-2 CSAC)



Marywood finished the week with a 1-1 record behind one of the most outstanding single game performances by a Pacer athlete. **Ashley Murray** scored 41 points to break a 30-year scoring record in a 72-65 victory over Gwynedd Mercy. The Pacers trailed by as many as 13 in the second half before Murray's 12-of-24 shooting ignited the comeback. Earlier in the week, Marywood fell to Cabrini 81-54. **Danielle Terranella** led with 15 points, and **Courtney Murray** recorded four blocks. The Pacers travel to Centenary Wednesday before facing the Cavaliers again on Saturday.

Neumann Knights (11-7, 8-3 CSAC)



Neumann went 2-1 in CSAC action last week and senior **Erica Marvel** hit the 1,000 point plateau in a win at Cairn. To start the week, the Knights defeated Gwynedd Mercy 77-74 at home. **Jessica Schlesman** led all scorers with 33 points. The junior went 18-for-21 from the line and made key shots in the final seconds to seal the win. **Colleen Hinde** netted 14 points and Marvel notched 13. **JoHanna Metzger** pulled down 11 boards and blocked two shots. Neumann then fell to Rosemont in overtime, 75-68. **Schlesman** continued her dominating week by scoring with 20 points. Metzger netted 16 points and **Jordan Ogden** added 11. **Marvel** hit her 1,000th point in a 86-43 win at Cairn on a three pointer just six seconds into the game. She finished with 13 points as five players reached double-digits. **Nicole Fallon** finished with 17 points, leading the Knights. **Colleen Hinde** netted 14 points. **Metzger** had a double-double with 13 points and 10 boards. **Ogden** also netted 13 points. Neumann travels to Manhattanville on Monday for non-conference action. The Knights then take on Immaculata on Saturday in CSAC action.

Notre Dame Gators (1-17, 1-9 CSAC)



The Gators dropped three CSAC contests to Immaculata, 84-17, Cairn, 38-30 and Cedar Crest, 56-26 last week. **Naimani Staley** paced the Gators with a game-high 15 points versus the Highlanders. **Staley** added 13 more points to go along with five assists and five steals in the loss to the Falcons. Notre Dame travels to Gwynedd Mercy on Wednesday and hosts Baptist Bible Saturday in CSAC action.

Rosemont Ravens (6-10, 4-4 CSAC)



On Monday night the Ravens doubled-up the home Cairn Highlanders, 92-46. On Wednesday, the Ravens' **Liz Coyne** scored 29 with 23 rebounds on the way to winning a competitive 75-68 game over the Neumann Knights in overtime. It was the Ravens' third straight win and evened up their conference record at 4-4. This, Wednesday night the Ravens host the Mighty Macs of Immaculata, while on Saturday afternoon the Ravens host the Keystone Giants in a re-match of the teams who faced each other in the 2012-2013 CSAC Quarterfinal.
