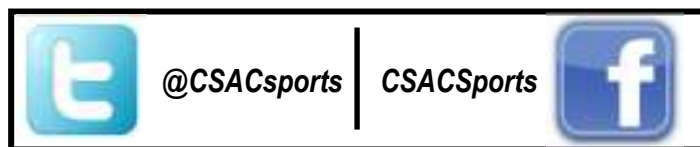
Dominic was lethal from downtown in three games, going 11-for-17 (64%) in a 1-2 week.

In Saturday's game with King's, she sank five three-pointers in totaling 17 points.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Baptist Bible Defenders (0-5, 0-2 CSAC)



The Lady Defenders will take the court for the first time since before Christmas on Monday night as they host non-conference foe, Susquehanna University. BBC will get back to conference play on Wednesday as they travel to Cabrini College and to Immaculata University on Saturday.

Cabrini Cavaliers (8-3, 3-0 CSAC)



The Cavaliers fell to 8-3 on the season after a 1-2 week. After a three-week holiday break, Cabrini returned to action with a 58-45 loss at Albright. The Blue and White then split a pair of games at the NYU Holiday Classic, topping Juniata 68-54 and falling to the host Violets 69-58. Senior **Brittany Sandone** was named to the All-Classic Team after averaging 17 points on 5-9 from three point range over the weekend. The Blue and white will return to Nerney Field House on Wednesday, as they host Baptist Bible at 6 p.m. before welcoming Centenary to campus on Saturday for Alumni Day.

Cairn Highlanders (0-6, 0-3 CSAC)



Cairn has been idle since Dec. 7. The Highlanders' next contest is slated for Jan. 8 versus Stevens Institute of Technology.

Cedar Crest Falcons (1-9, 0-3 CSAC)



The Falcons opened up 2014 on the road at Hollins University in Roanoke, VA. The Falcons would drop the contest 62-30. Top scorers for the Falcons included senior **Amber Wehry** who netted 10 points and 7 rebounds, junior **Breonna Lewis** who collected 8 points and 6 rebounds and freshman **Taylor Osley** who added 8 points and 3 rebounds.

Centenary Cyclones (4-6, 2-0 CSAC)



Centenary was defeated in its first game following a nine-day holiday break, falling at Kean 78-72 on December 30. The Cyclones trailed by 21 points with 9:14 remaining in the second half before cutting the Cougars' lead to just three, but could not get any closer. Sophomore **Ally Fugnitti** scored a team-high 18 points and added five assists and four steals. Freshmen forwards **Mallory George** and **Kelsey Barofski** combined for 30 points, 13 boards and six assists. After a three-game road trip, Centenary returns to Hacketts-town for the first time since Dec. 7 on Wednesday when it hosts Gwynedd Mercy. The Cyclones conclude their week at Cabrini on Saturday.

Gwynedd Mercy Griffins (4-7, 1-2 CSAC)



The Griffins headed out west during the holiday break to partake in the Vegas Hoopla. On Sunday, December 29th, Gwynedd fell to Eastern Connecticut State, 67-60. The following day, GM pulled a upset of #20 Vassar, 82-74. Five players hit double figures as junior **Kelsey Yori** and sophomore **Chandler DiFebbo** each had career highs of 18 points apiece. On Saturday, Gwynedd saw King's rally for an 87-82 win at the Griffin Complex. Junior **Natasha Matthews** had 16 points and 11 rebounds for her second-straight double-double.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Immaculata Mighty Macs (7-3, 3-0 CSAC)



Immaculata finished runner-up at the Roosevelt's Moravian Winter Classic, while junior forward **Brittany Merkle** earned a spot on the All-Tournament Team. Immaculata defeated Wilkes, 63-55, in the opener to earn a spot in the championship game, and the Mighty Macs fell to the host Moravian Greyhounds in the title game, 63-46. **Merkle** averaged 10.5 points and 8.5 rebounds during the two tournament games to lead Immaculata in both scoring and rebounding. **Sara Smith** and **Alison Zimny** each averaged 8.5 points for the weekend, while **Smith** brought down 6.0 rebounds per outing. Immaculata returns to conference play on Wednesday hosting Notre Dame in the first of two meetings between the schools in the next two weeks.

Keystone Giants (8-2, 3-0 CSAC)



Alyssa Cuomo scored a career-high 24 points and pulled down nine rebounds on Saturday afternoon to lead Keystone to a 77-68 win at Drew University in their first game since December 16th. **Chantel Blake** added 19 points and seven rebounds and **Jazmyn Robinson** finished with 17 points, seven steals, six rebounds, and six assists in the win over the Rangers. Keystone then rolled to an 85-37 victory at Valley Forge Christian College on Sunday. **Blake** led the Giants with 21 points while **Cuomo** (16 points, 11 rebounds) and **Robinson** (13 points, 10 assists) added double-doubles. **Ashley Evans** netted 17 points and **Jerica Rode** added 11 points in the win. Keystone will host Wells College on Tuesday night and Eastern University on Thursday night for a pair of non-conference games on the week.

Marywood Pacers (7-3, 3-0 CSAC)



After winning its first seven games, Marywood has dropped its last three. The Pacers lost both games at the Las Vegas Hoopla in late December. The Pacers fell to No. 3 Amherst College 73-49. **Maddie Lavery** scored eight points. The following day, Eastern Connecticut State ousted the Pacers 83-40. **Brittany Mang** led the charge with 22 points and eight rebounds. Marywood looks to get back to the win column against King's on Monday before hosting Cedar Crest and Neumann.

Neumann Knights (4-6, 1-2 CSAC)



Neumann (4-6) went 1-1 to open 2014. First, the Knights travels to Albright and fell 85-62. **Erica Marvel** led four Knights in double-digits with 13 points. **Jessica Schlesman** added 11 points and six assists. **Nicole Fallon** notched 11 points off the bench. **JoHanna Metzger** netted 10 points. On Saturday, Neumann used a strong second half to defeat Eastern 67-50. After falling behind early, the Knights ended the first half on an 11-3 run to pull to within three. Neumann then opened the second half with the first eight points and outscored the Eagles 20-4 in the first 10 minutes. **Colleen Hinde** led the Knights with 24 points and 11 rebounds. **Schlesman** netted 13 points while **Marvel** added 10. The Knights head back into conference action, beginning with Rosemont at home on Wednesday. Neumann then travels to Marywood on Saturday.

Notre Dame Gators (0-11, 0-3 CSAC)



Notre Dame opened the second half of the season by hosting Penn State Abington on Saturday, falling to the visitors 28-66. The Gators were led by sophomore **Kam Medina**, who led the squad with 21 points and 9 rebounds. **Medina** also posted two steals and a block. The Gators will resume conference play by travelling to Immaculata University on Wednesday and hosting Cairn University on Saturday.

Rosemont Ravens (3-7, 1-2 CSAC)



Liz Coyne scored 24 with 10 rebounds to help the Ravens snap Lancaster Bible's four-game winning streak, 71-67. **Brianna Macauley** scored 12 with 13 boards for her first career double-double. **Coyne's** double-double was her 10th in 10 games. **Kierra Smith** added 10 for the Ravens who are 2-0 at home. The Ravens have a busy week ahead, hosting PSU-Berks in a non-conference game on Monday and then traveling to Neumann on Wednesday. Rosemont returns home on Saturday to face a tough DeSales team in another non-conference game.
