AROUND THE CSAC

BAPTIST BIBLE DEFENDERS (0-4, 0-0)

The Lady Defenders went 0-3 in their second week of the season. In their first home game of 2014-15, BBC fell to Arcadia University 36-93. Heading to Florida for the weekend, the Lady Defenders participated in the Clearwater Christian College Pre-Feast Tournament. On Friday they fell 24-77 to Kentucky Christian and on Saturday, after holding a 24-22 lead at the half, the Lady Defenders couldn't hold on, as they lost to the host school 52-55. With Thanksgiving week off, the team will return to action on December 3, as they go up against conference opponent, Centenary College, on the road.

CABRINI CAVALIERS (1-2, 0-0)

Cabrini posted a 1-2 mark through the first week of the season. The Cavaliers opened with a 72-61 home loss to Eastern, despite a career high 25 points and 16 rebounds from senior **Amber Keys**. Junior **Kristina Startare** recorded a career high 16 points in the Blue and White's 69-58 loss at Widener. The Blue and White scored its first victory on Saturday, as it topped Delaware Valley 54-49. Freshman **Erin Dodds'** 13 points led four Cavaliers in double figure scoring. Keys also entered the Cabrini record book, as her 12 rebounds made her the 16th player in program history to surpass 500 career rebounds. The Cavaliers will welcome Albright to Nerney Field House on Tuesday before opening CSAC play after the holiday break.

CAIRN HIGHLANDERS (3-2, 0-0)

Cairn women's basketball went 1-3 this week after opening with a loss to Penn State Hazleton on Monday, 47-63. The Highlanders then traveled to the University of Valley Forge for a three-day event and defeated the hosts 58-46 but lost to Johnson University (Tenn.) 70-34 and Trinity Baptist College 71-46. The women will take the week off of competition before hosting their first of the season on Dec. 6, against Gwynedd Mercy University.

CEDAR CREST FALCONS (1-3, 0-0)

The Cedar Crest College Basketball team finished the week 0-3, losing to PSU-Lehigh 66-54, PSU-Abington 66-36 and Morrisville State 63-36. The Falcons finished fourth in the Hilton Garden Inn Tournament this past weekend hosted by the Falcons. Senior **Breonna Lewis** notched two double-doubles for the weekend while guard **Taylor Osley** collected 11 points and five rebounds for the weekend. The Falcons will have the week off for a academic break before returning to action on December 1 when they travel to St. Joseph's College-Brooklyn.

CENTENARY CYCLONES (1-3, 0-0)

The women's basketball team dropped both games this week as they were defeated by Ramapo College (69-78) and Drew University (57-71). Sophomore **Mallory George** led the offense with 27 points and 26 boards, 18 of which came against Ramapo for a double-double performance. **Kelsey Barofski** also chipped in 19 points, while Freshmen **Rachel Edwards** and **Taylor Pryslak** added 17 and 16 points respectively. The Cyclones have one more non-conference game against Stevens Institute of Technology Nov. 25th @ 7:00 p.m.

GWYNEDD MERCY GRIFFINS (1-2, 0-0)

Gwynedd Mercy couldn't catch DeSales as the Griffins fell at the Bulldogs, 72-59, Thursday night in non-conference action. Junior **Chandler DiFebbo** led GM with 16 points. Senior **Natasha Matthews** added 12 while grabbing a game-high seven rebounds. The Griffins will open CSAC play on Monday night when they welcome Neumann to the Griffin Complex in a 7 p.m. tip.

IMMACULATA MIGHTY MACS (0-3, 0-0)

Immaculata continued its opening home stand with two games last week against Moravian and DeSales. The Mighty Macs came up short in both outings, falling 84-80 to Moravian and 63-58 against DeSales. **Sara Smith** averaged 19 points per game last week with a 26-point effort against Moravian. **Adriana Sciascia** averaged 15 points per outing. Immaculata looks to close out the four-game home stand with a win Monday against Lancaster Bible in its only contest of the week.

KEYSTONE GIANTS (2-3, 0-0)

The Giants went 1-2 on the week, earning a thrilling, 98-96 victory at Cazenovia on Tuesday before falling to Albright on Saturday (82-72) and Utica on Sunday (71-65). **Ashley Evans** scored a game-high 31 points in Tuesday's win over the Wildcats and the senior hit the game-winning three-pointer with 7 seconds left. **Alyssa Cuomo** led Keystone with 22 points while **Cierra Hensley** added her first career double-double on 10 points and 12 rebounds on Saturday at Albright. **Cuomo** again led the Giants on Sunday against the Pioneers with 24 points while **Jazmyn Robinson** dished out a season-high eight assists. Keystone will visit Eastern University on Tuesday night in their lone contest of the week.

MARYWOOD PACERS (1-2, 0-0)

Marywood struggled from the field in a 78-55 loss to Wilkes in its only action this week. **Nora Joyce** was the lone Pacer in double-digits with 15 points. **Maddie Lavery** pulled in a game-high seven boards. Marywood plays its first home game Tuesday when it hosts Penn State Lehigh Valley.

NEUMANN KNIGHTS (2-1, 0-0)

Neumann lost its only game of the week at Widener on Saturday by a 67-57 score. **Holly McKaig** led the Knights with 20 points. **Jessica Schlesman** added 16 points. **Ericka Smith-Sowell** recorded a double-double for the Knights with 11 points and 13 rebounds. The Knights are set to travel to Gwynedd Mercy on Monday for their first conference game of the year. The Knights wrap up the week at Eastern on Saturday.

NOTRE DAME GATORS (1-2, 0-0)

Notre Dame stumbled against their cross-town rival Goucher College on Thursday night. Leading the way for the Gators was freshman **Kaitlyn Walter**, as she posted 12 points, including hitting four three-pointers to lead the team to a 50% shooting night from the three point line. Freshman **Stephanie Roche** added 10 points to the Gators effort while freshman **Allyson Whitacre** posted three assists. Notre Dame fell in the contest 87-36.

ROSEMONT RAVENS (0-3, 0-0)

The Ravens opened their season with an 0-3 record against some tough competition. Rosemont opened their season on Tuesday, coming up short against Eastern by a 75-59 score. This past weekend the Ravens lost both games in the Pepsi Tip-Off Tournament, hosted by Susquehanna University. Both losses were nail-biters with the Ravens coming up on the short end of a 72-67 result against the host Crusaders on Saturday. On Sunday the Ravens again hung tough, but lost to the College of Staten Island, 75-70. **Liz Coyne** notched her first two double-doubles of the season in the opening week while teammate **Curtrena Goff** scored a career-high 20 points against Staten Island. The Ravens begin their conference record on Tuesday when they host the Gators of Notre Dame (MD), and end the week on Sunday against Arcadia University.
