AROUND THE CSAC

BAPTIST BIBLE DEFENDERS (0-4, 0-0)

After having the week off, the Lady Defenders will open up their conference schedule this week as they take to the road, facing Centenary College on Wednesday night before hosting Notre Dame of Maryland University on Saturday afternoon.

CABRINI CAVALIERS (2-2, 0-0)

The Cavaliers scored the game's final five points to break a 51-51 tie with 60 seconds to play, evening its record at 2-2 with Tuesday's 56-51 win over Albright College. Senior **Amber Keys** led the Blue and White charge with 21 points and career highs of 19 rebounds and five blocked shots. Junior **Dana Peterson** tallied 14 points and five assists, while classmate **Kristina Startare** added 10 points and five rebounds. The Blue and White will open CSAC lay on Wednesday, as they visit Gwynedd Mercy before hosting Cedar Crest on Friday.

CAIRN HIGHLANDERS (2-3, 0-0)

Cairn was off from competition last week. They will resume play and open conference play on Saturday as the Highlanders host Gwynedd Mercy University at 2 pm.

CEDAR CREST FALCONS (1-4, 0-0)

The Falcons enjoyed a week off after hosting the Hilton Garden Inn Tournament last weekend. This week the Falcons tip off against St. Joe's-Brooklyn (12/1), Keystone (12/3), Cabrini (12/5) and Franklin and Marshall (12/8).

CENTENARY CYCLONES (1-4, 0-0)

The Centenary women's basketball team dropped their lone match of the week to Stevens Institute of Technology by a final score of 82-58. **Mallory George** led the offense with a game-high 20 points on 8-of-15 shooting from the field and brought down seven rebounds. Junior guard **Ally Fugnitti** also added eight points in the loss with five assists. **Kelsey Barofski**, **Rachel Edwards**, **Taylor Pryslak** and **Melissa Rabe** each contributed to the Cyclones with five points each.

GWYNEDD MERCY GRIFFINS (2-2, 1-0)

Gwynedd senior **Natasha Matthews** led the way with a double-double as she scored 26 points and pulled in 10 rebounds as the Griffins handed Neumann a 81-74 loss to kick off Colonial States Athletic Conference play Monday night. Three more players would go on to hit double digits in the Griffins only match-up of the week. The Griffins return to action next Wednesday as they continue CSAC play against defending champion Cabrini in front of a home crowd. Tip-off is set for 6 p.m.

IMMACULATA MIGHTY MACS (1-3, 0-0)

Immaculata closed out its four-game home stand on Monday evening with a 58-42 victory against Lancaster Bible for its first win this season. **Sara Smith** scored a game-high 20 points, and **Adriana Sciascia** added 14 for the Mighty Macs. **Brittany Merkle** brought down 11 rebounds as Immaculata won the battle on the boards, 44-38, against Lancaster Bible. Immaculata plays at Richard Stockton Monday before beginning CSAC play at Notre Dame Wednesday and hosting Marywood on Saturday.

KEYSTONE GIANTS (2-4, 0-0)

Keystone dropped a 94-64 decision at Eastern University on Tuesday night in their lone contest of the week. **Jazmyn Robinson** led Keystone with 13 points and five assists. **Alyssa Cuomo** added 11 points while **Cierra Hensley** finished with nine points on the loss to the Eagles. The Giants will open conference play this week with a pair of CSAC games on the road. Keystone will visit Cedar Crest College on Wednesday night before traveling to Rosemont College on Saturday afternoon.

AROUND THE CSAC

MARYWOOD PACERS (2-2, 0-0)

Marywood evened its record to 2-2 with a 73-46 victory over Penn State Lehigh Valley in its only game of the week. **Tara Steakin** was the lone Pacers player in double figures with 14 points. **Courtney Murray** led the team with eight rebounds and added seven points. **Danielle Terranella** had nine points and six boards. The Pacers forced 28 PSU Lehigh Valley turnovers. Marywood opens conference play Wednesday with Rosemont before traveling to Immaculata Saturday.

NEUMANN KNIGHTS (2-3, 0-1)

Neumann went 0-2 last week. On Monday, the Knights lost to Gwynedd Mercy to open CSAC action, 81-74. **Jessica Schlesman** recorded a double-double in the Knights effort. On Saturday, the Knights lost to Eastern by a score of 85-31. Neumann will host Swarthmore on Wednesday before traveling to Centenary on Saturday for a conference match-up.

NOTRE DAME GATORS (1-4, 0-1)

On Tuesday, basketball fell in their conference opener to Rosemont College, but saw two players with 15 or more points. As a team the Gators reeled in a total 40 rebounds and 12 steals. After Thanksgiving, the Notre Dame traveled to Penn State-Abington in a non-conference match up. The Gators tied the game five times and were down by two at half, but fell to the Nittany Lions. Three players scored double figures while the Gators shot 75% from the free throw line. Many Gators saw team and individual highs throughout the week.

ROSEMONT RAVENS (1-4, 1-0)

The Ravens earned their first win of the season when they opened their conference schedule on Tuesday against Notre Dame (MD). Five Ravens scored in double-figures, led by **Leilani Naone-Carter's** 14 points as the Ravens took the 87-52 decision. Rosemont played a determined brand of ball against the visiting Knights of Arcadia, but were defeated by the Knights 80-75 at Alumnae Hall. **Liz Coyne's** 17 points led the Ravens. The Ravens hit the road for a CSAC game at Marywood on Wednesday followed by a home game vs. the Keystone Giants on Saturday.
