Coyne only missed four shots from the field this week, shooting 17-for-21 for an outstanding 81% shooting percentage. On the defensive side she was credited with a total of nine steals.

Baptist Bible Defenders (2-15, 2-10 CSAC)



The Lady Defenders went 1-1 on week, (0-1 CSAC). On Monday night, the Lady Defenders fell in their final non-conference contest of the year to Lancaster Bible College. The Chargers went home with a 79-52 win, despite 13 points for **Corin Landry**. Rosemont College came to town on Saturday for senior day and handed the Lady Defenders a 83-41 loss. BBC will host Centenary College on Monday night, then take to the road on Wednesday at Keystone and Saturday at Gwynedd Mercy University.

Cabrini Cavaliers (16-4, 10-1 CSAC)



Due to last week's weather issues, the Cabrini women have not seen action since a Feb. 1 victory at Marywood. The Cavaliers will return to action tonight as they host Cedar Crest before visiting Immaculata on Wednesday. The Blue and White will return to its home floor on Saturday as Neumann visits campus.

Cairn Highlanders (1-18, 1-12 CSAC)



Cairn dropped a pair of CSAC games this week against Cedar Crest and Gwynedd Mercy. The Lady Highlanders were led by **EJ Hartzler** and **Amie Eppolito** both tallying 13 points for the game against Cedar Crest. On Saturday, Cairn struggled to compete with the Griffins of Gwynedd Mercy. **Eppolito** drained 16 points for a team high and **Emily Tambussi** contributed seven points and nine rebounds of her own. The Highlanders travel to Scranton, PA on Wednesday night to face Marywood University in another CSAC clash and then will head to Valley Forge Christian on Saturday.

Cedar Crest Falcons (6-13, 4-7 CSAC)



Thanks to the winter weather, the Cedar Crest College Falcons played just one game this week resulting in a 59-34 win over CSAC opponent Cairn University. For the Falcons **Amber Wehry** finished with a double-double with 13 rebounds and 12 points while teammate **Breonna Lewis** finished with 23 points and 18 rebounds.

Centenary Cyclones (8-13, 6-6 CSAC)



Centenary rebounded from a heartbreaking mid-week loss to Immaculata by defeating Notre Dame (Md.) 61-21 on Saturday. All 11 Cyclones to see action against the Gators scored at least two points and nine tallied at least one steal. Freshman forward **Melissa Rabe's** 14-point, 11-rebound double-double was the first of her career. She also added three blocks and two steals. Centenary rallied from a 16-point deficit against Immaculata, but a last-second Mighty Mac shot gave IU a 60-58 victory. Freshman forward **Mallory George** scored a game-high 21 points for her fifth 20-point performance, while senior guard **Klarissa Perry** added 11 points, eight rebounds and five assists. Centenary closes out the regular season with four-straight road games beginning Monday at Baptist Bible.

Gwynedd Mercy Griffins (11-10, 8-4 CSAC)



Gwynedd Mercy notched a bevy of season highs with a 109-29 CSAC win over visiting Cairn on Saturday at the Griffin Complex for their fourth win in a row. **Chandler DiFebbo** led all scorers with a game-high 18 points tied a personal mark with four three pointers. **Nicole Dougherty** added 15 and **Jordan Dominic** chipped in 11. **Jackie Crowley** pulled down a personal high 10 rebounds. The Griffins travel to Rosemont for a conference clash on Wednesday in a 7 p.m. tip.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Immaculata Mighty Macs (16-5, 11-1 CSAC)



Immaculata was able to stay in first place in the CSAC standings following two come-from-behind victories last week. Immaculata was able to defeat Centenary on the road (60-58) before downing Marywood at home, 70-63. With the two victories, Immaculata reached double-digit wins in the conference for the third time in the last four seasons. Immaculata trailed in both games heading into the final three minutes of action as **Adriana Sciascia** and **Alison Zimny** played key roles in both wins for the Mighty Macs. **Sciascia** was the team's leading scorer in both contests with 18 points against the Cyclones and 21 opposite the Pacers. Against Marywood, she had six points during the final two minutes, including the basket that gave the Mighty Macs the lead. **Zimny** scored the final five points for Immaculata against Centenary, including the game-winner at the buzzer.

Marywood Pacers (12-8, 7-5 CSAC)



A second half blackout swung the momentum in Immaculata's favor, and the Mighty Macs capped a 15-2 run over the final three minutes to overtake Marywood Saturday by a 70-63 score in the Pacers' only game this week. The Pacers led by six, following a pair of **Morgann Haduck** free throws, before the Mighty Macs ascent. The Pacers' **Maddie Lavery** notched the first double-double of her career with 16 points and 11 rebounds. **Haduck** reached double digits with 12 points. The Pacers face Scranton Monday in a rescheduled game from Wednesday. In the apex of the playoff hunt, Marywood hosts Cairn and travels to Cedar Crest this week.

Notre Dame Gators (1-21, 1-13 CSAC)



The Notre Dame basketball team took on two Colonial States Athletic Conference foes fighting for a playoff appearance as the Gators travelled to Centenary College Saturday afternoon, then returned to action Sunday to host Rosemont College. In Saturday's contest with the host Cyclones, Notre Dame was led by freshman **Erika Deppenschmidt's** 12 points. Defensively, junior **Marylu Ortiz** notched three blocked shots while junior **Shaun-de' Jones** posted nine rebounds. On Sunday, the Gators took on the visiting Ravens with **Deppenschmidt** adding 13 points. Freshmen **Stephanie Miller** and **Briana Johnson** both chipped in with two steals. **Johnson** also led the squad with nine rebounds, good enough for a career high in her short time with the team. This week, Notre Dame will travel to CSAC rival Neumann University and will face the Knights for the second time this season.

Keystone Giants (12-9, 6-6 CSAC)



Keystone dropped a 76-59 decision at Neumann University on Saturday afternoon in its lone contest of the week.

Ashley Evans and **Aaliya Hayes** scored 18 points apiece to lead the Giants while **Alyssa Cuomo** netted 10 points.

Chantel Blake led all players with 13 rebounds while **Jazmyn Robinson** collected four steals in the loss.

Keystone will host its Think Pink Night Wednesday evening when against Baptist Bible College and will host Immaculata University on Saturday afternoon.

Neumann Knights (13-8, 10-3 CSAC)



Neumann picked up a 76-59 win against Keystone in the lone game of the week. **Erica Marvel** led all players with 20 points, including four from beyond the arc. **JoHanna Metzger** and **Jordan Ogden** each had 14 points and 10 rebounds. **Colleen Hinde** added 10 points. **Lauren Walker** pulled down 11 boards. This week, the Knights host Notre Dame on Wednesday before traveling to Cabrini Saturday.

Rosemont Ravens (9-11, 7-5 CSAC)



The Ravens flexed their defensive muscle this week, winning their two conference games on the road by large margins. On Saturday at Clarks Summit, **Liz Coyne** scored 25 points in 28 minutes of play, assisted by **Lauren Whelan's** 15 points to defeat Baptist Bible 83-41. On Sunday at Baltimore, **Coyne** the Ravens placed four players in double-figures led by **Coyne's** 19 points in 20 minutes as the Ravens dominated Notre Dame (MD) 79-15. The Ravens play two home games this week, hosting Gwynedd Mercy on Wednesday and Centenary on Saturday.
