Cuomo led Keystone to a 2-0 CSAC week by averaging team-highs of 17.0 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Scored a career-high 29 points to go along with nine rebounds in Wednesday's 95-53 win over Baptist Bible before adding seven rebounds and five points, including the final two from the line to ice a 75-70 win over Immaculata on Saturday. She shot 52.0 percent from the field and 38.5 percent from three-point range on the week.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Baptist Bible Defenders (2-18, 2-13 CSAC)



BBC had a full week as they took on three CSAC games, going 0-3. Centenary College game to town on Monday and drove home with a 63-34 win. On Wednesday the Lady Defenders made the short trip to Keystone College and came up empty, falling 95-53, and on Saturday BBC was upended by Gwynedd Mercy University 87-27. **Erika Longwell** led the Lady Defenders on the week, averaging 10 ppg and nearly 7 rpg. She had a standout performance against Keystone College as she went for 18 points and 10 rebounds, earning herself another double-double.

Cabrini Cavaliers (19-4, 13-1 CSAC)



Cabrini improved to 19-4 (13-1 CSAC) and extended its win streak to seven games with a 3-0 week. Senior **Annie Rivituso** posted 13 points, 10 rebounds, seven assists and four steals in the Blue and White's 83-43 win at Cedar Crest. On Wednesday, Cabrini rallied from an 11 point second half deficit to score a 59-48 win at Immaculata behind a combined 45 points from **Rivituso**, senior **Brittany Sandone** and junior **Amber Keys**. The Blue and White closed the week with an exciting 69-62 overtime win over Neumann. **Sandone's** three pointer with 5.9 seconds in regulation tied the score before Cabrini took over the extra period. The Cavaliers will visit Gwynedd Mercy tonight before closing the regular season on Wednesday with a visit from Keystone.

Cairn Highlanders (1-20, 1-13 CSAC)



The Lady Highlanders went 0-2 last week against the Pacers of Marywood University and the Valley Forge Patriots. A poor first half against the Pacers on Wednesday night overshadowed an impressive offensive firepower in the second half between Cairn's top shooters, **Amie Eppolito** (27 points) and **EJ Hartzler** (12 points). The pair combined for eleven three pointers for the night, closing the gap that had formed early on in the first half but were defeated, 65-49. On Saturday, Cairn came out strong against the Patriots in the first half but unfortunately Valley Forge began a run that would blow the game wide open. **Hartzler** and **Emily Tambussi** each contributed 13 points for the game. In the end the Highlanders fell by a score of 72-44. Cairn will take on the Mighty Macs of Immaculata University tonight and then will travel to Rosemont College for their final game of the season Wednesday night.

Cedar Crest Falcons (6-16, 4-10 CSAC)



The Falcons finished this week 0-3 overall and in the CSAC with a 83-43 loss to Cabrini, a 69-40 loss to Centenary and a 74-37 loss to Marywood. Senior **Amber Wehry** finished the week averaging 10.6 points per game while teammate and junior **Breonna Lewis** also finished the week averaging 10.6 points per game. The Falcons will wrap up the season this week (weather pending) with conference match-ups against Rosemont and Notre-Dame (MD) and a non-conference match-up against Bryn Athyn.

Centenary Cyclones (10-14, 8-7 CSAC)



Centenary posted two victories during three CSAC road games last week. Freshman forward **Mallory George** averaged 18.7 points per game to pace the Cyclone offense and recorded her eighth double-double with a 23-point, 16-rebound performance during Centenary's 69-40 victory over Cedar Crest. **George** has made 90 free throws, the fourth-highest single-season total in Centenary history and the second-most among CSAC players this winter. Despite dropping a key league matchup at Rosemont on Saturday, Centenary remains alive in the hunt for the sixth seed in the CSAC Tournament. The Cyclones must defeat Marywood in the regular-season finale plus get additional help to clinch their first berth in the tournament since the 2010-11 season.

Gwynedd Mercy Griffins (13-10, 10-4 CSAC)



Senior **Nicole Dougherty** posted her first career double-double to help Gwynedd Mercy win its fifth game in a row in an 81-64 CSAC win at Rosemont on Wednesday night. The Griffins would cruise to their sixth-straight victory by downing Baptist Bible, 87-27, Saturday afternoon in a CSAC matchup. Senior **Jordan Dominic** led the charge with a game-high 16 points. Junior **Kelsey Yori** added 11 points and a team-high seven rebounds. Gwynedd welcomes Cabrini on Monday at 7 p.m. in a rescheduled game from February 5th. GM can secure a #2 seed and a first-round playoff bye with a win on Monday and a win on Wednesday over Immaculata.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Immaculata Mighty Macs (16-7, 11-3 CSAC)



Immaculata had its first back-to-back losses of the season last week as it dropped a home contest to CSAC-leader Cabrini, 59-48, and then fell on the road at Keystone, 70-75. **Adriana Sciascia**, who averaged 13.5 points per game during the two games, scored a team-high 19 points against Cabrini. **Alison Zimny** also averaged double-digits in scoring for the week (13.0) as she finished with a game-high 19 points opposite Keystone. **Brittany Merkle** had a monster week on the boards for the Mighty Macs with 16 rebounds per outing. **Merkle** led Immaculata with a career-high 17 rebounds against Cabrini and followed that with a double-double of 13 points and 15 caroms at Keystone. Immaculata closes out the regular season with its Play 4Kay contest Monday against Cairn and then is at Gwynedd Mercy on Wednesday.

Marywood Pacers (14-9, 9-5 CSAC)



Marywood put an end to a four-game losing streak with two consecutive wins over conference opponents. The Pacers began the week by dropping a 72-58 contest to cross-town rival Scranton. **Brittany Mang** scored 13 points. The Pacers jolted to a 38-11 halftime lead in a 65-49 victory over Cairn. **Carly Leitzel** was all over the court with seven rebounds, six assists and six steals. Marywood capped the week with a 74-37 victory over Cedar Crest. The Pacers started off on a 22-1 run and saw 13 points from **Ashley Murray**. Marywood sits in the fifth place in the CSAC with key matchups at Keystone Monday and versus Centenary Wednesday with playoff implications on the line.

Notre Dame Gators (1-22, 1-14 CSAC)



The Notre Dame of Maryland University basketball team travelled to Colonial States Athletic Conference foe Neumann University. The Gators were led by freshman **Erika Deppenschmidt** with five points. Junior **Shaun De' Jones** contributed four points and grabbed seven rebounds for Notre Dame. The Gators gave a strong effort, but in the end were unable to put in enough baskets to keep pace with Neumann. The game ended with a final score of 78-11. Notre Dame will be back in action on Tuesday, February 18 when they host Trinity Washington University for their annual "Play4Kay" pink game.

Keystone Giants (14-9, 8-6 CSAC)



Alyssa Cuomo scored a career-high 29 points to lead the Giants to a 95-53 win over Baptist Bible on Keystone's Think Pink Night. **Ashley Evans** and **AAliya Hayes** netted 14 points apiece in the win while **Samantha Donahue** (13) and **Chantel Blake** (10) also reached double-figures in the victory over the Defenders. On Saturday against Immaculata, the Giants held off a late rally attempt by Immaculata to earn a crucial, 75-70 victory over the Mighty Macs. **Blake** scored 19 points, **Robinson** had 17 points, while **Hayes** (12) and **Evans** (11) also reached double-figures. Keystone will close the regular season with a pair of key conference matchups with playoff implications on the line as the Giants host Marywood on Monday before traveling to Cabrini on Wednesday.

Neumann Knights (14-9, 11-4 CSAC)



Neumann went 1-1 in conference action last week. The Knights picked up a convincing 78-11 win against Notre Dame on Wednesday evening. **Nicole Fallon** led the Knights with 18 points. **JoHanna Metzger** added the Knights with 17 points and 10 rebounds. **Lauren Walker** netted 12 points. On Saturday, the Knights fell at Cabrini 69-62 in overtime. **Erica Marvel** led the Knights with 17 points. **Jessica Schlesman** added 13. Neumann wraps up the regular season at Baptist Bible on Wednesday.

Rosemont Ravens (10-12, 8-6 CSAC)



The Ravens finished the week 1-1 after two important CSAC home games the past week. On Wednesday, Gwynedd Mercy continued their hot play, raining 11 three-point baskets on their way to defeating Rosemont 81-64. In a must-win situation for Rosemont to have a chance at earning a post-season berth the Ravens were solid against the Centenary Cyclones. The Ravens made some timely three-point baskets (eight treys in the game) while **Liz Coyne** notched her 17th double-double with 19 points and 16 boards as Rosemont won 74-63. The Ravens need both to win both games this week as they finish up their regular season. On Monday they travel to Allentown to face Cedar Crest before Senior Night at Alumnae Hall on Wednesday against Cairn.
