# CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Baptist Bible Defenders (2-13, 2-9 CSAC)



The Lady Defenders picked up their second win of the season as they went 1-1 on the week. On Wednesday night, the Cavaliers came to town and handed BBC a 73-41 loss. The Lady Defenders ended their four game losing skid on Saturday as they held Notre Dame (MD) to their lowest offensive output of the season. BBC came away with a 57-9 win. **Erika Longwell** set a career high as she netted 23 points. This week the Lady Defenders will host Lancaster Bible College in the team's final non-conference contest of the season. On Saturday, BBC will host Rosemont College.

## Cabrini Cavaliers (16-4, 10-1 CSAC)



The Cavaliers improved to 16-4 overall and 10-1 in league play with a pair of conference wins last week. **Amber Keys'** 17 points led four Cavaliers in double figures as Cabrini scored at 73-41 win at Baptist Bible on Wednesday. Cabrini used a late defensive stand to claim a 58-48 win at Marywood on Saturday. **Annie Rivituso** paired 14 points and 17 rebounds as the Cavaliers held the Pacers to two points over the last 8:19 of the game. The Blue and White will visit Gwynedd Mercy on Wednesday before returning to Nerney Field House on Saturday to host Cedar Crest.

## Cairn Highlanders (1-16, 1-10 CSAC)



Cairn went 0-3 last week against Bryn Athyn (84-34), CSAC foe Keystone (83-46) and Trinity Washington (66-48). Amie Eppolito and EJ Hartzler played all 40 minutes and combined for 23 of Cairn's 34 points against the Lions. Hartzler once again logged all 40 minutes opposite Keystone, tallying a team-high 14 points, including four triples, and two steals. Eppolito poured in 27 points, including 11-of-14 from the foul line, in a close loss to the Tigers. Brigid Shehan and Emily Tambussi hauled in 10 rebounds apiece versus Trinity.

## Cedar Crest Falcons (5-13, 3-7 CSAC)



Cedar Crest was off last week and Monday's contest with Bryn Athyn was postponed due to snow. The Falcons will travel to Cairn Wednesday and Cabrini Saturday.

## Centenary Cyclones (7-12, 5-5 CSAC)



Centenary split a pair of CSAC games last week, defeating Marywood at home before falling on the road at Gwynedd Mercy. Four players scored in double figures against Marywood, led by freshman forward **Mallory George's** 20 points. **George** added 13 rebounds for her seventh double-double, the most by a Cyclone since the 2010-11 season. Freshman **Jessie Sharr** added 12 points and nine rebounds. Fifty-three percent of Centenary's scoring has come from its freshman class. Senior **Klarissa Perry** paced Centenary with 14 points against GMU. The Cyclones play their final two home games of the season this week beginning with Immaculata on Wednesday.

## Gwynedd Mercy Griffins (10-10, 7-4 CSAC)



The Griffins never trailed defeating Notre Dame of Maryland, 97-21, Wednesday night in CSAC action. The quartet of **Jordan Dominic**, **Natasha Matthews**, **Kristen Fuery** and **Kalene Coffey** led the Griffins in the scoring column with all four scoring 10. All 15 Griffins reached the scoring column, as Gwynedd shot a season-best 53.4% (39-of-73) from the field connecting on 13 three pointers. Gwynedd Mercy won its third game in a row defeating Centenary, 86-44, Saturday afternoon in a CSAC matchup. **Matthews** led all scorers with a game-high 18 points on 8-of-10 shooting. **Kelsey Yori** added 16 with her hot hand as she connected on four three pointers and **Charlotte Kucowski** rounded out the scoring, chipping in 12 points off of the bench. The Griffins shot 50.0% (33-of-66) from the floor and connected on a season-high 14 three pointers to cruise to the victory. Gwynedd dished out a season-high 28 assists as well. **Dominic** led GM with a team-high eight while adding nine points on 3-of-4 shooting from beyond the arc. The Griffins return back to action Wednesday when they host defending conference champion Cabrini.

# CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Immaculata Mighty Macs (14-5, 9-1 CSAC)



Immaculata extended its CSAC winning streak to start the season to nine games with a 63-58 road victory at Rosemont Wednesday evening. The Mighty Macs' undefeated conference streak then came to an end Saturday as Neumann handed Immaculata its first CSAC loss (63-59). **Sara Smith** averaged a double-double during the two games with 13.5 points and 11 rebounds per game. **Smith** was 11-for-21 (.524) from the field with five assists. **Smith** helped the Mighty Macs to their win at Rosemont with 16 points and 14 rebounds. **Alison Zimny** led the team with 15 points per game last week, posting 14 points against Rosemont and a team-leading 16 opposite Neumann.

## Keystone Giants (12-8, 6-5 CSAC)



**Jazmyn Robinson** scored a game-high 21 points to go along with a career-high nine steals and six assists while **Jerica Rode** recorded her first collegiate double-double on 14 points and a game-high 11 rebounds to lead Keystone to an 83-46 win at Cairn on Wednesday. **AAliya Hayes** added 19 points and **Ashley Evans** netted 13 points in the victory. **Evans** led five Giants in double-figures with 22 points on Saturday in a 92-88 loss at Rosemont. **Robinson** scored 18 points, **Chantel Blake** and **Alyssa Cuomo** scored 15 points apiece, and **Hayes** netted 13 points in the loss to the Ravens. Keystone will travel to Neumann on Saturday for their lone contest of the week.

## Marywood Pacers (12-7, 7-4 CSAC)



Marywood dropped a pair of CSAC games this week to fall to fourth place in the conference. The Pacers struggled from the field in a 63-49 loss to Centenary. **Nora Joyce** registered 11 points on a 6-for-6 performance from the free-throw line. **Brittany Mang** contributed defensively with a team-high eight rebounds and four steals. Cabrini held Marywood to just two points in the final 8:19 to break open a late second half tie en route to a 58-48 victory. The Pacers had the score tied at 46-46 before the Cavaliers finished on a 12-2 run to end the game. **Ashley Murray** scored 10 points. Marywood takes on cross-town rival Scranton Wednesday and travels to Immaculata Saturday.

## Neumann Knights (12-8, 9-3 CSAC)



Neumann handed Immaculata its first conference loss of the season on Saturday, 63-59. **Colleen Hinde** led the Knights with 14 points. **Jessica Schlesman** netted 11 points and **Erica Marvel** added 10. Earlier in the week, Neumann fell at Manhattanville 81-66 in non-conference action. **Marvel** led four Knights in double-figures with 17 points. **Colleen Hinde** and **Schlesman** each added 12 while **JoHanna Metzger** netted 10. Neumann hosts Penn State-Abington on Monday evening in non-conference action before hosting Keystone on Saturday for a CSAC contest.

## Notre Dame Gators (1-19, 1-11 CSAC)



Notre Dame traveled to CSAC foe Gwynedd Mercy University and hosted Baptist Bible College this week. Freshman **Erika Deppenschmidt** notched 17 points in her first career game at point guard and hit five three pointers in the process. Junior **Shaun-de' Jones** posted 17 rebounds during the week, grabbing 10 in Saturday's contest with Baptist Bible.

## Rosemont Ravens (7-11, 5-5 CSAC)



On Wednesday night the Ravens were tied with first-place Immaculata with 2:27 remaining before the Mighty Macs put together a 7-0 run to put the game away.
