Trill led the Pacers with nine goals and five assists through five games. The junior attack contributed two assists in a 10-7 win over Richard Stockton on Feb. 22. He tied for a game-high two goals in an 8-5 loss to King's. Trill totaled three goals and an assist in a win over Bridgewater (Va.), followed by a five-point performance (3g, 2a) against Randolph-Macon.



AROUND THE CSAC



CABRINI COLLEGE
4-0, 0-0 CSAC

The Cavaliers opened its 2014 with a 4-0 mark for the first time since 2008. After a slow start on Saturday, Cabrini found its stride and defeated Hampden-Sydney College 14-8. Junior **Tyler Johnston** led the way with 8 points on 4 goals and 4 assists. Fellow junior **Damian Sobieski** added three goals, including his 100th career point. The Blue and White will return to action on Wednesday when they welcome No. 16 Gettysburg to Edith Robb Dixon Field. No. 19 Nazareth will pay a visit on Saturday.



CENTENARY COLLEGE
1-1, 0-0 CSAC

Centenary began the 2014 campaign with an 11-5 victory over Maritime on March 1, its sixth consecutive season-opening triumph. Senior **Steve Orsini** and junior **Josh Caven** both tallied six points to pace the offense. Orsini fired in five goals and added one assist, while Caven tallied three goals and three helpers. Sophomore **Alex Malecki** earned his first collegiate victory in goal by making five saves in 30 minutes of action. Centenary then dropped a 9-3 decision to Oswego State on March 8. Caven found the back of the net twice, while sophomore **Anthony Biango** recorded a goal and one assist. Malecki and sophomore Kevin Switzer combined to make 15 saves. Centenary opens a three-game road trip at Richard Stockton on Wednesday.



GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY
1-2, 0-0 CSAC

The Griffins went 1-1 last week, picking up their first win of the year. On Wednesday, GM headed down to Marymount, but came out with an 8-6 defeat to the Saints. Junior **Matt Richter** scored twice to lead Gwynedd. In Saturday's 18-3 win over Mount Saint Mary, junior **Nico Belardo** had a career day, totaling three goals and four assists for seven points, all personal highs. Senior **Mason Risner** and sophomore **Tommy Belmont** added four goals apiece.



IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY

Immaculata opened the 2014 campaign with losses in its first three outings. Immaculata fell in three road contests to Arcadia (13-6), Richard Stockton (18-4) and Catholic (16-3). **Bhelly Bagbonon** led the Mighty Macs in those three games with four goals and five assists for nine points. **John Abruzzo** leads the squad with 11 ground balls and five caused turnovers.

Marywood won two out of its first five games to start the season. **Cody Bachman** and **Brandon Terlizzi** each had a hat trick in a 10-7 win over Richard Stockton on Feb. 22. King's overcame freezing temperatures to stop the Pacers 8-5 on Feb. 26. The Pacers received a win over former coach Mic Grant, defeating Bridgewater (Va.) 11-3 to start their Spring Break trip. **Sam Trill** had three goals. Marywood fell to Randolph Macon 14-13 in a back-and-forth game on Wednesday. **Scott Slater** scored a season-high six goals, and **Dylan Swope** tallied five helpers. McDaniel used a five-goal run to down the Pacers 9-6 Saturday. **Joe Magargal** stopped a career-best 19 shots. Marywood travels across town to face Scranton Wednesday before hosting Lebanon Valley this weekend.

Neumann has opened with four straight games at home. The Knights have come away with a 1-3 record, but have played well so far. In the first game, Neumann fell to King's in a close 6-5 game. **Patrick Rose** had a goal and an assist for the Knights. **Alex Becker** made 20 saves. Next, the Knights dropped a 10-7 decision to Elizabethtown. **Ryan Eber** led the Knights with five goals Becker made 13 saves in net. On a cold afternoon, Neumann could not keep up with Catholic and fell 10-4. **Chris Scott** netted two goals to lead the Knights. Becker made 21 saves and picked up nine ground balls. Eber won six face-offs and had 10 ground balls. The Knights broke through in the win column in a 12-4 victory again Regis. The Knights were led by **Kevin Fonio**, who netted three goals and one assists, while Eber added three goals. Rose scored two goals while dishing out two assists and Scott led the team with four assists while also scoring two goals. Becker minded the net, as he made 16 saves in the game to preserve the Knights win. He also picked up 10 ground balls. Neumann hits the road this week and travels to Misericordia on Wednesday.
