McCraw totaled 11 points on eight goals and three assists while winning 11-of-16 faceoffs in a 2-0 week. Against DeSales, he scored five goals and added two assists while adding eight groundballs and winning 6-of-7 faceoffs. In Saturday's win over Hood, he totaled four points on three goals and a helper. McCraw added four groundballs and won 5-of-9 faceoffs.



## AROUND THE CSAC



**CABRINI COLLEGE**  
6-0, 0-0 CSAC

Cabrini matched the best start in program history, as it improved to 6-0 with wins over No. 19 Gettysburg and Nazareth. Senior **Corey Elmer** led the Cavaliers with 8 points on 5 goals and 3 assists in a 17-5 win over Gettysburg. The senior scored his 100th career goal in the 20-11 win over Nazareth, one of his 7 points in the win. Junior **Tyler Johnston** added 7 points, including 5 assists, while fellow junior **Damian Sobeski** netted 5 goals. The Blue and White will welcome Whittier College to Edith Robb Dixon Field on Saturday.



**CENTENARY COLLEGE**  
1-3, 0-0 CSAC

Centenary was defeated in road games at Richard Stockton and Mount Saint Mary (N.Y.) last week. The Cyclones' offense mustered just four goals total during the losses. Sophomore goalkeepers **Alex Malecki** and **Kevin Switzer** split time in net. Malecki made 23 stops, including 17 during the first half against Stockton, while Switzer blocked 14 shots. Junior defender **Nick Perkalis** grabbed nine ground balls and recorded two caused turnovers versus Mt. St. Mary. Centenary travels to Virginia Beach for a Thursday night game with Nichols (Mass.) this week.



**GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY**  
3-2, 0-0 CSAC

The Griffins picked up two wins this week, defeating DeSales on Wednesday, 11-9, and Hood, 10-6, on Saturday. In Wednesday's win sophomore **Tony McCraw** scored five goals and added two assists while adding eight ground-balls and winning 6-of-7 faceoffs. Junior **Nico Belardo** chipped in two goals and three assists.



**IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY**  
0-4, 0-0 CSAC

In its only game of the week, Immaculata lost its home opener to Misericordia, 15-11. The Cougars opened the scoring with six-straight goals before the Mighty Macs' **Bhelly Bagbonon** (4 goals, 3 assists) notched a goal with 2:01 left in the quarter. Immaculata never led during the contest, but a five-goal run for the Mighty Macs spanning the third and fourth quarters brought the hosts within three (13-10) with 10 minutes remaining in the game. The three-goal margin was the closest Immaculata had been since the end of the first quarter (6-3).

Trailing by six goals late into the third period, Marywood scored the final nine goals of the game in a come-from-behind 11-8 win over Lebanon Valley. **Scott Slater** scored three consecutive goals to spark the Pacer comeback. The Pacers won nine of 10 faceoffs and outshot the Dutchmen 16-1 in the final period. **Michael Squillante** picked up 10 groundballs and won 11 of 14 faceoffs. Three straight Scranton goals scored late in the fourth period turned a stalemate into a 8-5 loss for the Pacers. **Riley Dobel** scored two goals. Marywood hosts York (Pa.) Wednesday in its only contest of the week.
