Justin Regan would lead the Ravens in scoring in both games played this week, bagging four goals in a win on Saturday, and two goals on Wednesday. Regan set the tone for the Ravens in their win against Alvernia University on Saturday. Tied 1-1, Regan would score three straight goals, all on assists from different teammates, to put the Ravens in front 4-1, a lead they would never relinquish. Earlier in the week Regan would score twice, striking early to put his team in front 1-0 against Arcadia.



## AROUND THE CSAC



**CABRINI COLLEGE**  
7-0, 0-0 CSAC

Cabrini improved to 7-0 with Saturday's 15-9 win over Whittier, marking the program's best start in school history. Junior **Tyler Johnston** paced the offense with 4 goals and an assist, while fellow junior **Damian Sobieski** added three goals and a helper. Senior **Bill McCabe** forced 4 turnovers, as freshman **Austin Marshall** recoded nine saves in his first career start. The Cavaliers will open CSAC play on Wednesday, as they welcome Immaculata to Edith Robb Dixon Field, before hosting No. 11 Ithaca on Saturday.



**CENTENARY COLLEGE**  
2-3, 0-0 CSAC

Centenary played its only game last week in Virginia Beach, Va., against Nichols (Mass.). The Cyclones defeated the Bison 14-11 to end a three-game losing skid. Centenary's 14 goals were its highest offensive output of the season. The Cyclones play home non-league games against FDU-Florham and Kean this week.



**GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY**  
4-3, 0-0 CSAC

Gwynedd Mercy powered its way to their fourth-straight win with a 21-10 victory over Western Connecticut State Thursday afternoon. Senior **Mason Risner** would score seven times, just one goal shy of the all-time school record. Junior **Nico Belardo** netted four goals and added three assists while fellow junior **Matt Richter** had three goals and three helpers. Sophomore **Tony McCraw** also recorded a hat trick. Lycoming escaped with a 7-6 win over Gwynedd Mercy, snapping the Griffins' four-game win streak on Saturday. Risner scored twice and Belardo added two assists. Risner and McCraw goals in the first quarter matched up the score 2-2 after one quarter of action. **Nick Guglielmi** and **Alfonzo Manzo** tallied goals in the third quarter for the Griffins. McCraw would win 14-of-17 face-offs, which was a career-high mark for the sophomore. Goalie **John Black** registered 10 stops in the contest. Gwynedd Mercy will get back at it on Wednesday when they travel to Arcadia for a 4 p.m. start.



**IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY**  
0-6, 0-0 CSAC

Immaculata went 0-2 last week in road contests as the Mighty Macs fell to both Widener (15-6) and Elizabethtown (11-3). **Rocco Piliero** led the way for the Mighty Macs with three goals and one assist. **Doug Hughes** and **Ben Lerario** also tallied two goals during the week. Goalie **Brien Cullen** played 102 minutes between the two games and recorded 31 saves.
