In Wednesday's game at Cabrini, Notre Dame saw junior **Brittany Peddicord** and sophomore **Sawyer Butto** notch goals in a 16-2 defeat at the hands of the Cavaliers. In Saturday's contest with the Griffins, the Gators played a strong second half, playing the hosts to a 9-9 tie. Unfortunately, a slow start by Notre Dame was too much to overcome, as the Gators fell behind 7-1 at the break. **Butto** posted the team's lone first half goal early in the first half to make the score 2-1. In the second half, Notre Dame pulled to within 10-7, fueled by three goals each by **Peddicord** and **Butto**. After two Griffin goals, freshman **Carrie Naylor** added a goal to make it 12-8, but four more goals by the hosts, and another goal for **Peddicord** and **Butto** made the 16-10 final.
