McCraw scored twice, added 14 groundballs and had a season-best in faceoff win percentage (82.3%), winning 19 of 23 faceoffs in a 16-5 win at Immaculata to help the Grifins clinch a playoff berth.



AROUND THE CSAC



CABRINI COLLEGE
11-1, 3-0 CSAC

The Cavaliers split a pair of games last week, extending their CSAC win streak to 99 games with Wednesday's 25-4 win over Neumann before suffering a 15-11 loss at No. 5 Salisbury. The trio of senior **Corey Elmer** and juniors **Damian Sobieski** and **Mike Leyden** combined for 13 goals and six assists against Neumann. Elmer paired five goals and two helpers against the Sea Gulls as the Blue and White fell to 11-1 on the season. Cabrini returns to CSAC play this week, as it visits Rosemont and Gwynedd Mercy this week.



CENTENARY COLLEGE
4-7, 2-2 CSAC

Centenary split a pair of CSAC home games last week, downing Rosemont 14-6 before being edged by Neumann 10-8. The Cyclones led the Ravens by two at the half, but outscored Rosemont 9-3 during the final 30 minutes to secure the win. Senior **Steve Orsini** led the way with three goals and two assists. Centenary battled back from a five-goal deficit against Neumann; however, a pair of goals by the Knights during the final 1:57 spoiled the Cyclones' first-ever game at J.E. Reeves Jr. Turf Field. Orsini and sophomore **Trevor Krupinski** both recorded two goals and one assist. **Kevin Switzer** made 29 saves in two games, including 15 against Neumann.



GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY
8-3, 4-0 CSAC

The Gwynedd Mercy Men's Lacrosse Team clinched a playoff berth with a 16-5 win at Immaculata on Wednesday. A total of eight different Griffins scored, led by **Richard Delea** who scored a career-high four goals. **Mason Risner** added three while the defense clamped down in the second half, allowing just two goals on six shots, turning a 6-3 lead at the break into a runaway victory. **Tony McCraw**, **Matt Richter**, and **Alfonzo Manzo** all added two goals apiece. McCraw would register his fifth-straight game with 10 or more groundballs (14) and face-off wins (19-of-23). Goalie **John Black** made nine saves. GM will entertain Cabrini next Thursday, April 17th at 4 p.m. in their final regular season home game.



IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY
0-12, 0-5 CSAC

Immaculata was 0-2 last week with losses to Gwynedd Mercy (16-5) and Marywood (21-8). **Bhelly Bagbonon** led the Mighty Macs with nine points (5 goals, 4 assists). Bagbonon's nine points during the week gave the senior attackman 100 points for his career with 108. Doug Hughes also finished the week with four goals and one assist. The Mighty Macs have their final CSAC game this season at Neumann on Wednesday.

AROUND THE CSAC



Marywood evened its overall record to 7-7 with victories over Susquehanna and Immaculata. **Cody Bachman** netted a game winner with 88 seconds remaining in triple overtime as Marywood defeated the Crusaders by a 9-8 score. It marked the longest game, by far, in school history. **Scott Slater** led with three goals. Marywood overcame a late comeback that saw Susquehanna score four uninterrupted goals to force overtime. It was Marywood's first win over a team that competed in the NCAA tournament the previous year. The Pacers followed that with a 21-8 win at Immaculata. **Dylan Swope** contributed two helpers for his 62nd career assist, breaking Nick Parks' school record. Slater had five goals, and five Pacers finished with four points. In both games this week, **Michael Squillante** won more than 70 percent of his faceoff opportunities. Marywood travels to Centenary on Thursday in its only contest this week.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY
7-7, 3-1 CSAC

Neumann (4-9, 1-3 CSAC) picked up its first conference win of the season as it split a pair of CSAC games. On Wednesday, the Knights fell at No. 2 Cabrini 25-4. Neumann scored all four of its goals in the third quarter. **Ryan O'Kane** scored two goals for the Knights. **Chris Scott** had a goal and two assists. **Kevin Fonio** had a goal and an assist. **Alex Becker** made 17 saves in net. On Saturday, the Knights defeated Centenary 10-8. **Ryan Lee** led the Knights with four goals. Fonio and **Patrick Rose** each had two goals and two assists. O'Kane tallied two goals and an assist. Becker made 12 saves in net. Lee broke an 8-8 tie with 1:57 left in regulation. O'Kane netted an insurance goal with 28 second left. This week, Neumann has one game when it will host Immaculata on Wednesday beginning at 4:00 PM.
