Fitzgerald led Immaculata to four of its seven wins last week posting just a 0.25 earned run average. She pitched 28 innings allowing just 13 hits and one earned run while striking out 27 hitters. Opponents batted just .133 against her during the four games. She allowed just two hits to both Marywood and Baptist Bible, and tossed a three-hitter against Gwynedd Mercy. She recorded a season-high nine strikeouts against Cairn.

**CSAC HONOR ROLL**

**LIZ BIDDLE - Immaculata - Fr - DP**

Biddle helped Immaculata to a 7-1 record in CSAC play last week hitting .462 (12-26) with two doubles and two home runs. She scored seven runs and drove in nine. She posted a .769 slugging percentage and .481 on-base percentage. She has three hits a game against Cairn and Gwynedd Mercy.

**STEPHANIE MILLER - Notre Dame - Fr - SS**

Miller paced Notre Dame's 5-2 week by scoring 12 runs on 14 hits, including a double, triple and inside the park home run. She hit .560 (14-of-25) and drove in seven runs.

**ASHLEY FALLON - Notre Dame - Fr - P**

Fallon went 3-0 in the circle and racked up 26 strikeouts in 19 innings pitched. She posted a 3.79 ERA as the Gators swept Trinity and Cedar Crest and split with Rosemont.

**MEAGAN MADSEN - Centenary - Sr - P**

Madsen earned two victories last week, including a complete-game shutout against Cairn on Saturday. The shutout was the 16th of her career, most all-time by a Cyclone. She collected her 40th career win on Sunday after holding Notre Dame scoreless during the final five innings of a 17-9 victory. Sunday marked Madsen's 100th-career appearance in the circle, the seventh-highest total among active Division III pitchers. For the week, Madsen struck out four and allowed opposing hitters to bat just .208.

# CSAC SOFTBALL NOTES

## BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE DEFENDERS (5-14, 3-5 CSAC)



The Lady Defenders went 2-4 on the week, as all six games were conference contests. On Wednesday, BBC hosted Immaculata University and fell 15-0 and 11-1. Things turned around on Thursday, as the team took a double header from Cedar Crest College, 14-8 and 11-10. The team could not carry that momentum into Saturday's contests as Neumann University took the weekend series 8-0 and 15-0. **Lauren Shepherd** had seven hits on the week, including going 4-for-4 in one game against the Falcons. She had three doubles and four RBIs. Both **Aleisha Buchanan** and **Jenna Bont** recorded 5 RBIs on the week. The Lady Defenders will take on Marywood University on the road on Monday, host Keystone College on Wednesday and end the week at home on Thursday against Notre Dame.

## CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (12-13, 9-5 CSAC)



The Cavaliers split their six games last week, closing the week at 12-13, including 9-5 in the CSAC. The Blue and White split a non-conference doubleheader at Arcadia before sweeping two games from Delaware Valley. The Blue and White closed the week with a pair of losses at Marywood. Freshman **Amber Dietrich** led the club with a .500 average with 6 RBI and two triples. Junior **Becca Miles** also knocked in six runs last week. The Cavaliers step out of conference play for its three dates this week. They host Wesley on Monday, visit Widener on Tuesday and host Valley Forge Christian on Thursday.

## CAIRN UNIVERSITY HIGHLANDERS (8-17, 3-11 CSAC)



The Highlanders continued to struggle last week as they were unable to come out with any wins against their opponents. On Tuesday, Cairn had two very close games against PSU-Hazleton but unfortunately dropped both games to the Lions, 7-8 and 1-2. On Wednesday, the Highlanders lost to Eastern University, 0-5 and 2-7. Cairn resumed conference play over the weekend as they faced Immaculata University Friday afternoon and Centenary College on Saturday. The Mighty Macs defeated Cairn 1-6 and 6-9 on Friday and Centenary played a complete shutout for the day against the Highlanders, 0-4 and 0-3. Cairn looks forward this week in hopes to better their record as they face Trinity University this afternoon and Cedar Crest College for conference play on Friday afternoon.

## CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (1-21, 1-13 CSAC)



The Falcons wrapped up a busy week of softball on Saturday. Cedar Crest traveled to Rosemont (W12-3, L6-16), hosted Baptist Bible (L8-14, L11-10) and hosted Notre Dame (MD) (L3-15, L4-14). **Shannon Wenner** and **Javara Troupe** continued their hot hitting as **Wenner** raised her season batting average to .500 and **Troupe** to .438. The Falcons will host Rutgers-Newark before hitting the road in more CSAC action.

## CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (8-18, 8-5 CSAC)



Centenary won three CSAC games last week, upping its league record to 7-5. **Meagan Madsen** and **Kylie Morgan-Polefka** both tossed complete-game shutouts on Saturday against Cairn. **Madsen** extended her own school record with her 16th-career shutout, while **Morgan-Polefka** recorded the first of her collegiate career and helped her own cause at the plate with her first home run. Centenary rallied from a 9-1 deficit to defeat Notre Dame 17-9 on Sunday. The teams were completing a suspended game from March 29. The Gators scored all nine of their runs in the first inning on March 29, but **Madsen** blanked them in five innings on Sunday, striking out four. **Heather Passaro** was 4-for-4 at the plate with five runs scored and four RBI, while **Caitlyn Dean** added two hits and knocked in three. Centenary opens an eight-game road trip Monday at Rowan.

## GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY GRIFFINS (6-17, 6-4 CSAC)



Gwynedd Mercy suffered its first CSAC losses of the season, as defending champion Neumann handed the Griffins doubleheader defeats on Wednesday, 12-3 and 8-1. An RBI groundout in the first from **Ashley Lamont** and a two-out RBI single in the second from freshman **Nikki Canfield** staked GM to a 2-0 lead. **Lamont** would allow just two hits up until the fifth where the Knights were able to load the bases with no outs. GM got a run back in the bottom half of the fifth on sac fly from **Stephanie Farrar**. The Knights would pull away scoring six runs in the top the of the sixth to pull away for the game 1 victory. Immaculata took two from GM on Saturday, winning game one, 7-1, and game two, 4-3. **Lamont** struck out six over six innings of work. In game two, the Griffins would battle back from a 3-1 deficit with a run in the sixth and one in the seventh, but the Mighty Macs plate the game-winner on a walk-off RBI single. **Alexis Deal** would go 1-for-2 with a run scored and a stolen base. The Griffins lost a pair of games at Arcadia on Sunday, 8-0 and 2-1. After getting out of a bases loaded jam in the sixth, Gwynedd would tie it at 1-1, getting a run in the top of the seventh when **MaryKate Ballerino** would score to tie it up. ## IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (17-7, 14-2 CSAC)
