They blew open a 4-3 game with seven straight goals in the middle of the first half to take a commanding lead that they wouldn't let up the rest of the way. On Tuesday, Immaculata was trailing Cabrini 4-3 in the first half before the Cavaliers ripped off 14 straight goals to take control of the game. Immaculata will play at Notre Dame on Wednesday in their regular season finale before preparing for the playoffs.
