CSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

DAMIAN SOBIESKI

Cabrini - Jr - Midfield

Landenberg, Pa./Avon Grove



Sobieski paired 12 goals and 3 assists in Cabrini's 2-0 week. The junior posted a career high 8 points in a 25-4 win at Rosemont, including 5 goals to become the 5th Cabrini player to record at least 100 career goals. His career high 7 goals in a 17-6 win over Gwynedd Mercy helped Cabrini take sole possession of first place in the CSAC.

CSAC WEEKLY HONOR ROLL

MICHAEL SQUILLANTE

Marywood - So - Midfield

Stanhope, N.J./Lenape Valley Regional

Michael Squillante won 21 of 23 faceoffs, at a 90.3 percent clip, to engineer a 15-7 second-half Marywood comeback over Centenary. He scooped 14 ground balls and also scored a key goal down the stretch. Squillante broke the season ground ball record with his 103rd, breaking Brandon Terlizzi's 2013 record of 98. He came three short of the single game ground ball record (17). Squillante has won more than 70 percent of faceoffs each of the past three games.



AROUND THE CSAC



CABRINI COLLEGE
13-1, 5-0 CSAC

The No. 5 Cavaliers improved to 13-1, including 5-0 in the CSAC with wins at Rosemont and Gwynedd Mercy. The victories also extended Cabrini's CSAC win streak to 101 games, one shy of the NCAA record. Juniors **Damian Sobieski** and **Mike Leyden** led the Cavaliers with career highs of eight and seven points, respectively, in Cabrini's 25-4 win at Rosemont, while **Sobieski** became the ninth Cavalier to reach 100 career goals. **Sobieski** added a career high seven goals in a 17-6 win at Gwynedd Mercy that gave the Blue and White sole possession of 1st place in the league. Senior **Corey Elmer** added eight points on three goals and five assists to move into third place on Cabrini's all time points (239) and assists (109) lists. Cabrini will close the regular season on Thursday with a visit from Centenary College.



CENTENARY COLLEGE
5-8, 2-3 CSAC

Centenary won one-of-two games last week, topping Alvernia 11-7 before falling 15-7 to Marywood. **Steve Orsini** posted three goals during both games, while **Kenton Gottshall** added four goals and one assist. Goalkeeper **Kevin Switzer** stopped 14 shots against Alvernia to earn his fourth win and posted 22 saves versus Marywood. **Switzer** owns the league's third-highest save percentage at .618. Centenary closes out the regular season at Cabrini on Thursday.



GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY
8-4, 4-1 CSAC

Gwynedd Mercy suffered their first conference loss as Cabrini handed the Griffins a 17-6 defeat Thursday afternoon. The loss also snaps Gwynedd's three game winning streak. **Mason Risner** scored twice and added an assist as the senior now sits one goal behind the all-time leader. The Griffins did get on the board first, as **Tony McCraw** found the back of the net 52 second into the contest. The Cavaliers responded, netting three straight. The teams would trade goals to end the half, putting the Cavs on top 7-3 at halftime. **McCraw** and freshman **Marc Bushong** led GM with six groundballs apiece. **Bushong** and **Reese Lachner** each had two caused turnovers. Goalie **Ryan Murphy** recorded a career-high 14 saves in net. GM closes out the regular season with a conference game at Marywood. The Griffins have clinched a playoff spot and the winner of Thursday's game will claim the #2 seed and a home playoff game.



IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY
0-13, 0-6 CSAC

Immaculata concluded the CSAC slate last week with an 11-9 loss on the road at Neumann. **Bhelly Bagbonon** scored a team-leading three goals and one assist, and **Doug Hughes** and **Michael Thompson** each scored two goals. Immaculata plays the final contest of the 2014 season on Thursday hosting Bryn Athyn.

AROUND THE CSAC



The Pacers won their only matchup of the week, coming from behind in the second half to win 15-7 over Centenary. **Michael Squillante** won 21 of 23 faceoff chances and scooped up 14 ground balls. He broke the school record with his 103rd ground ball of the year. **Riley Dobel** led the Pacers with six goals and two assists. **Ryan Nowell** added nine ground balls and three caused turnovers. **Dylan Swope** broke the single season assist record with his 28th of the year. Marywood hosts Gwynedd Mercy Thursday in a battle for the No. 2 seed.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY
8-7, 4-1 CSAC

Neumann (5-9, 2-3 CSAC) picked up an 11-9 win against Immaculata in the only game of the week. **Ryan O'Kane** netted four goals to lead the Knights. **Patrick Rose** scored three goals. **Kevin Fonio** had two goals and two assists. **Alex Becker** made 17 saves in net. Rose scored the only two goals of the third quarter for a 7-7 game heading into the final 15 minutes. Neumann scored four goals to open the fourth quarter, as part of seven straight going back to the end of the first half. Immaculata netted the final two goals of regulation, but Neumann held on for the 11-9 conference win. The Knights wrap up the regular season on Thursday evening then they host Rosemont in conference action beginning at 7:00 PM.

The nationally-ranked Cabrini Cavaliers proved to be too much for the Ravens, breaking open a 1-1 score to run out 25-4 winners at the Ravens Athletic Complex.
