CSAC SOFTBALL NOTES

BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE DEFENDERS (6-17, 4-8 CSAC)



On Monday, the Lady Defenders took on Marywood University, with both Coach **Bill Higley** and Coach **Bob Fitzsimmons** sitting at 199 career wins. The Pacers blanked the Lady Defenders and 10-0 in both games, giving Coach Fitzsimmons his 200th career win. **Coach Higley** would reach the milestone on Thursday, in a wild 15-14 win over the Gators of Notre Dame (MD). In the second game of the double header, the Gators got even and won 16-2. In the final week of the regular season BBC will host Keystone College on Monday, travel to Cabrini College on Tuesday, host Gwynedd Mercy University on Wednesday and host Centenary College of Thursday. On Friday, they team will have the day off, as they finish up the week at Cairn University on Saturday.

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (14-15, 9-5 CSAC)



The Cavaliers split a pair of doubleheaders last week, dropping two games to Wesley 8-3 and 6-5 before sweeping Valley Forge Christian 8-0 and 8-1. Freshman **Amber Dietrich** went 6-11 on the week with five runs scored, while junior **Steph Dielgel** went 5-11 with three doubles, a home run, five RBI and three runs scored. The Cavaliers face a busy week, as they will visit Gwynedd Mercy on Monday, before hosting Baptist Bible and Notre Dame (MD.) and closing its CSAC slate on Saturday at Rosemont.

CAIRN UNIVERSITY HIGHLANDERS (12-17, 5-11 CSAC)



The Highlanders went 4-0 last week defeating Trinity University and CSAC rival Cedar Crest College. On Monday, Cairn traveled to Washington D.C. to play against Trinity and came out with two wins, 12-2 and 7-4. The Highlanders faced Cedar Crest on Friday morning tacking on two more wins, 9-0 and 8-0. Today, Cairn will play against Notre Dame of Maryland in Baltimore, MD and then will host Gwynedd Mercy and Baptist Bible for doubleheaders on Friday and Saturday.

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (1-27, 1-17 CSAC)



The Falcons dropped all of their games this past week. First to Rutgers Newark (L0-9, L0-17) conference opponent Neumann University (L0-11, L0-10) and lastly Cairn University (L0-9, L0-8). This week the Falcons will travel to Keystone College for a conference double-header on the 22nd, before returning home on the 26th for their season finale again Centenary College. Game time on the 22nd is schedule for 3:30 PM while the 26th is scheduled to begin at 12:30 PM. Offensively for the Falcons sophomore **Kali Jones** raised her season average to .266 while freshman **Ciara Lane** brought hers up to .286. Senior **Shannon Wenner** continues to lead the Falcons with a .444 batting average while junior **Javara Troupe** is batting an even .400.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (8-21, 8-6 CSAC)



Centenary split a back-and-forth doubleheader at Marywood on Thursday, taking game one 7-6 before falling 8-7 in nine innings during the nightcap. Game one featured three lead changes and three ties and Marywood had to rally for three runs in the bottom of the ninth to clip the Cyclones in game two. **Meagan Madsen** earned her 41st-career victory in the circle, second-most all-time at Centenary. The Cyclones collected 21 hits during the twinbill, including five from freshman **Heather Passaro**. **Passaro** also scored four runs and knocked in two, while **Alexis Wilson** crossed home four times. Centenary was also swept by Rowan earlier in the week. The Cyclones close out the regular season with 10 games this week, eight of which will be on the road.

GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY GRIFFINS (9-18, 9-5 CSAC)



Gwynedd Mercy was able to grind out a split in a CSAC DH at Keystone on Monday, winning the second game, 4-3, after dropping the first, 7-4. The Griffins got a go-ahead RBI single with two outs from **Megan Kelly** in the top of the seventh to break a 3-3 tie and to go on and snap a seven game winless streak. Down 3-1 going into the fifth, Gwynedd rallied to knot things up with one swing as **MaryKate Ballerino** smacked her third HR of the season, this one a two-run shot. **Maria Sesarco** had two hits, including an RBI double. **Jennifer Whalen** picked up her first win of the season, scattering two earned runs, with four Ks. In game one, **Sesarco** would double home **Ashley Lamont** in the second for a 1-0 lead, but the Giants answered in the bottom half of the frame with six runs on eight hits. **Ballerino** and **Kelsey McDonough** both homered for the Griffins. **Lamont** fanned five, but just walked one on the mound. The Griffins returned to action on Wednesday taking a pair of games from Rosemont 14-1 and 5-2. In game one GIM pounded out 17 hits. **Stephanie Farrar**, **Kelsey McDonough**, **Sesarco** and **Nikki Canfield** each had three hits for the game. **McDonough** drove in a team high five RBI's. **Lamont** went the distance on the mound striking out seven giving up just the lone earned run. Game two **Lamont** went the distance again fanning four to pick up her second win on the day. **Farrar** went a perfect 4-for-4 at the plate with a double, **Ballerino** added three hits with an RBI. Gwynedd has a huge week as they make their playoff push hosting Cabrini on Monday and Marywood on Tuesday. They will finish the week on the road traveling to Baptist Bible on Wednesday and closing out the regular season on Friday at Cairn.

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (19-7, 16-2 CSAC)



Immaculata swept Notre Dame of Maryland, 17-2 and 24-2, in its only action last week. The Mighty Macs scheduled games with Alvernia last week were cancelled. **Meghan Kugler** hit .714 (5-for-7) against the Gators with five RBIs and five runs scored. **Danielle Palmisano** had a team-high six RBIs and **Liz Biddle** also drove in five runs. **Meagan Fitzgerald** (11-2) got the win in the opener allowing just four hits and striking out 11 Gators.

KEYSTONE COLLEGE GIANTS (7-17, 4-10 CSAC)



Keystone went 2-2 on the week while having two doubleheaders rained out. The Giants split with Gwynedd Mercy on Monday, winning game one 7-4 before dropping the nightcap, 4-3 before Wilkes swept a pair of non-conference games on Thursday. **Karissa Worobey** and **Emily Long** had seven hits apiece to lead Keystone while **Sara Schraden** led the squad with five RBIs and four runs scored on the week. MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (14-8, 13-3 CSAC)



Marywood University head softball coach **Bob Fitzsimmons** earned his 200th career victory as the Pacers swept Baptist Bible College in a two-game CSAC series, with both games ending by scores of 10-0 after 4 1/2 innings. **Fitzsimmons** entered the doubleheader one win shy of the career milestone, as did BBC coach **Bill Higley**. **Fitzsimmons** becomes the winningest coach in Marywood athletics history, surpassing former women's tennis coach **Janice Kane-Winslow**, who had 199 career victories. Marywood would split CSAC action with Centenary Thursday, falling in the opener 7-6 and winning the nightcap 8-7 in nine innings. Marywood finished the week 3-1.

NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (20-6, 16-2 CSAC)



Neumann (20-6, 16-2 CSAC) shut out Cedar Crest College in a CSAC doubleheader in the only games of the week. In each game, the Knights scored eight runs in the first inning en route to the wins. **Lauren Wilkie** started game one and went 2.0 innings. She allowed one hit and struck out four. **Haley Broomell** went 2.0 innings and picked up the win. She did not allow a hit and struck out four. **Melissa Rozumalski** pitched the fifth inning and allowed a hit and struck out two. In game two, **Kristin Beaty** started the game and went 4.0 innings. She allowed one hit and struck out five as she faced the minimum amount of batters. **Allyson Parris** pitched the fifth inning. **Beaty** also hit a homerun in game two. Neumann has three doubleheaders this week, beginning with Rosemont on Tuesday. The Knights then host Widener on Wednesday before rounding out the regular season at Immaculata on Saturday.

NOTRE DAME OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY GATORS (8-12, 4-12 CSAC)



Notre Dame took a 16-2 victory at Baptist Bible on Thursday to tie the program's record for wins in a season. The Gators took a big lead early, notching nine runs in the second-inning with each player crossing the plate in the inning. In the opener with BBC, the Gators took a 13-5 lead in the top of the third, powered by a six-run second inning but were unable to deter the Defenders from an eight-run third inning to tie the game. The hosts added two more runs in the fourth, and despite the Gators posting a run in the seventh, Notre Dame fell 15-14. Wednesday, the squad hosted Immaculata in a conference DH, but ended up falling in the games. **Stephanie Miller** knocked two triples and a home run during the week and also paced the team with nine runs and five runs batted in. She also led the team with nine Ks in seven innings of action. **Brea Kehr** added six runs for the week and five RBIs. She also tied **Miller** with four stolen bases. **Tawny Cevora** chipped in with eight RBIs and five hits while throwing six Ks. The squad will also look to become the first softball team to reach double-figure wins in program history.
