The Cavaliers also rallied from an 8-4 halftime deficit to score a 14-12 win over Colorado College. Junior **Melissa Scanzano** led the Blue and White in all three games, totaling 12 goals and two assists on the week, including a career high six goals in the win over Colorado. The Cavaliers will close the regular season with home games against Rosemont and No. 4 TCNJ.

The Cedar Crest College lacrosse team finished this past week 0-3 overall and 0-2 in the CSAC. The Falcons would drop to Neumann (L3-21), Rosemont (L2-15) and Bryn Athyn (L8-14). The Falcons lone remaining game is the 22nd when they will travel to Gwynedd Mercy University for a CSAC contest under the light beginning at 7 PM. The Falcons finished with 13 goals this past week, led by sophomore **Vivianna Samite's** four goal performance against the Lions on the 17th. Freshman **Regina Gill** would also tally two goals in the contest against the Lions. In their conference games, **Samite** would team with **Jen Harbison** and **Emily Rodenberger** to score against Neumann and **Kim Barry** and **Amber Wehry** would both score against Rosemont. On the field **DeJanet Lantion** set a season high for the Falcons, collecting 11 ground balls against Rosemont and causing five turnovers.

Prior to the game, senior **Laura Kaufman** was honored as a part of the senior day festivities. **Kaufman** then went out to give the Gators an early 1-0 lead with her sixth goal of the season in the eighth minute. After **Sawyer Butto** and **Brittany Peddicord** sandwiched a Mighty Mac goal, Notre Dame held a 3-1 lead 12 minutes into the contest. The visitors responded by posting 10 straight goals and took an 11-3 lead. The Gators fought back to pull within 15-10, fueled behind five **Peddicord** goals, but the hosts couldn't come any closer, falling 22-12 in the contest. On Monday, Notre Dame travelled to Rutgers University-Camden where the team won the second half 10-7, but it wouldn't be enough after falling behind early in the game, dropping the game 20-14.
