**EMILY LONG - Keystone - Fr - OF**

Long batted .459 (17-37) while leading Keystone with 15 RBIs and tying for the team-lead with 17 hits in the team's 5-5 week (5-3 CSAC). The freshman outfielder had five doubles and one home run on the week and had at least one hit in nine of the team's 10 games including seven multi-hit games. In Monday's DH sweep of Baptist Bible, Long went 6-8 with five RBIs.

**TIFFANY GOWER - Cairn - Fr - P**

Gower went 3-0 in conference play this week. In 25 innings pitched, she gave up four earned runs and struck out 13 with a 1.44 ERA and holding opponents to a .191 batting average.

# CSAC SOFTBALL NOTES

## BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE DEFENDERS (7-26, 5-17 CSAC)



It was a busy week for the Lady Defenders as they played 10 games on the week. The team seemed to play better and better as the week went on and in their final CSAC game of the season, the Lady Defenders ended their 10 game losing streak with a 7-6 victory over Cairn University. On Monday, Keystone College came to town and took two from BBC, 9-1 and 3-1. At Cabrini College on Tuesday, the Lady Defenders fell 11-2 and 3-1. Gwynedd Mercy University upended BBC 5-3 and 9-4 and on Friday Centenary College won 8-1 and 12-2. In their final double header of the season, Cairn University won game one in 10 innings, 8-7, but the Lady Defenders won game two 7-6, as **Jenna Bont** went 3-4 and came in for the save. The team will end its season with a night time doubleheader at Wilkes University on Monday night, starting at 6:00 pm.

## CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (22-15, 17-5 CSAC)



Cabrini extended its win streak to 10 games with Gwynedd Mercy, Baptist Bible, Notre Dame (Md.) and Rosemont. The Cavaliers closed the regular season with an overall record of 22-15, the program's first 20 win season since 2010. Its CSAC mark of 17-5 is the team's best since 2005. Junior **Steph Diegel** led the club at the plate last week, going 11-25, including five doubles, seven RBI and seven runs scored. Freshman **Amber Dietrich** matched **Diegel's** 11 hits, including 2 home runs to lead the league with eight. Freshmen pitchers **Taylor Gallagher** and **Kiley Sharp** combined for a 0.84 ERA and 32 strikeouts on the week. Making its first CSAC Tournament appearance since 2010, the Cavaliers will host Centenary College in Monday's opening round match-up.

## CAIRN UNIVERSITY HIGHLANDERS (15-20, 8-14 CSAC)



The Cairn Highlanders went 3-3 on the week all in league play. Unfortunately, the Highlanders were not able to capture a berth in the postseason. Cairn split with all three series with Gwynedd Mercy (1-0, 0-2), Notre Dame (3-1, 4-7), and Baptist Bible (8-7, 6-7). Highlanders picked up a huge win against Gwynedd Mercy with a dominating pitching performance from **Tiffany Gower** going 8 innings giving up only 3 hits.

## CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (1-31, 1-21 CSAC)



The Cedar Crest College softball team wrapped up the 2014 spring schedule last week, playing against conference opponent Keystone (L1-9, L0-6) and Centenary College (L1-9, L3-7). The Falcons finish the year 1-31 and 1-21 in the CSAC. Highlights of this past week include senior **Shannon Wenner** collecting her 150th career hit against Centenary College in game two.

## CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (15-24, 14-8 CSAC)



Centenary went 7-3 during a busy, 10-game week to close out the regular season. The Cyclones have earned the No. 5 seed in the CSAC Tournament and will make their sixth consecutive appearance in the postseason under the leadership of Head Coach **Kim Broking**. Centenary won back-to-back CSAC titles in 2011 and 2012. Senior pitcher **Meagan Madsen** earned four victories in the circle, while freshman **Kylie Morgan-Polefka** picked up three wins and a save. **Madsen** now owns 45 career wins, second-most in school history, and is one of seven active Division III pitchers with at least 100 career appearances. Senior **Katie Ciecwisz** recorded four two-hit games, upping her career hit total to 160.

## GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY GRIFFINS (12-23, 12-10 CSAC)



Cabrini swept a CSAC DH on Monday over the Griffins, winning game one, 7-4, and the second, 8-0. **Megan Kelly** singled twice and scored twice while senior **Stephanie Farrar** added two hits as well. At Baptist Bible on Wednesday, the Griffins took game one, 5-3, and the second, 9-4. In game one, Gwynedd used a four-run sixth to erase a 3-1 deficit. GM used key hits from **Kelsey McDonough**, an RBI triple, and **Alexis Deal**, an RBI single, in the inning. **Jennifer Whalen** also did it on the mound and at the plate in game two. While fanning seven she went 3-for-4 with a two-run single in the fifth. **McDonough** and **Farrar** each tripled. **Farrar** finished with two hits and a run scored. Gwynedd Mercy punched its ticket to the postseason with a doubleheader split at Cairn on Friday with a win in game two, 2-0. The Highlanders took game one, 1-0, Game two starter **Whalen** allowed just three hits with six strikeouts and no walks. **Whalen, Farrar** and **Bentley** were each 2-for-3 at the plate. **Farrar's** two hits went for doubles. In game one, **Nikki Canfield** had two hits, going 2-for-3 with a pair of stolen bases. Gwynedd played its final regular-season home games of the season but fell in two very close contests to Marywood on Senior Day. The Pacers won game one, 5-4, and the second, 6-4. In game one, **Whalen** went 3-for-3 at the plate. **Deal** and **Farrar** each had two hits. Game two **Farrar** would triple and score twice. **McDonough** went 2-for-2 with two RBI's and a walk. Senior **Hillary Ware** added two hits and an RBI. GM will play on Monday in a first-round playoff game of the 2014 CSAC Softball Tournament at Immaculata.

# CSAC SOFTBALL NOTES

## IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (23-9, 19-3 CSAC)



Immaculata ended the last week of the regular season with a 4-2 overall and 3-1 CSAC record. The Mighty Macs concluded the regular season with a 23-9 overall and 19-3 league mark as they set single-season marks in both win columns. Immaculata split with Ursinus and Neumann while sweeping Centenary. **Brittany Merkle** led the Mighty Macs with .375 batting average, six hits, three doubles and six RBIs in the six games last week. Immaculata enters the CSAC Tournament for the sixth-straight year.

## KEYSTONE COLLEGE GIANTS (12-22, 9-13 CSAC)



Keystone went 5-5 (5-3 CSAC) while playing five doubleheaders last week. The Giants swept conference twin bills at Baptist Bible and Cedar Crest on Monday and Wednesday before dropping a pair of non-conference games on Thursday at King's. Marywood ended Keystone's postseason hopes by taking a pair of game from the Giants on Friday before the team earned a split at Notre Dame of Maryland on Saturday. **Emily Long** and **Sara Schraden** had 17 hits apiece on the week with **Long** driving 15 runs and **Schraden** scoring a team-leading nine runs. **Schraden** went 3-1 on the mound with 21 strikeouts while **Karissa Worobey** recorded 28 Ks in eight appearances in the circle. Keystone will close out the 2014 season on Monday with a non-conference doubleheader against Misericordia in La Plume.

## MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (21-11, 19-3 CSAC)



The Pacers went 7-3 on the week with a 6-0 mark in CSAC action. Marywood clinched the top seed in the upcoming playoffs by winning a three-way tiebreaker against Neumann and Immaculata. All three teams finished with a 19-3 regular season mark. **Brooke Labs** hit .483 for the week, collecting four doubles, one triple and six RBI. **Lindsey Gibbs** was 3-1 on the mound, with her only loss to non-conference opponent Wilkes.

## NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (23-9, 19-3 CSAC)



Neumann (23-9, 19-3 CSAC) went 3-3 overall and 3-1 in CSAC action last week. The Knights started with a sweep of Rosemont, 11-1 and 8-0. Neumann then fell to Widener 8-5 and 4-0. The Knights wrapped up the week with a split at Immaculata. They took the first game 9-1 and fell in the nightcap 6-5. **Becca Reinhart** had her 200th career hit in the first game at Immaculata. **Megan Williams** led the Knights with 11 hits for the week. **Becky Guinto** had eight hits and eight RBI. **Lauren Wilkie** picked up two wins and struck out 14 in 16.0 innings. Neumann is the No. 2 seed heading into the CSAC postseason this week.

## NOTRE DAME OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY GATORS (10-16, 6-16 CSAC)



Notre Dame made program history twice during the week while freshman **Stephanie Miller** set a season record. The Gators opened the week by setting the schools record for wins in a season, claiming their ninth victory of the season with a 7-4 win over Cairn on Monday. With the game tied at 3-3, Notre Dame took advantage of a four-run fourth inning fueled by two Highlander errors to claim the victory. In Saturday's first game with Keystone, this year's team became the first team in program history to reach double-digit wins by defeating the Giants 11-8. The Gators faced a deficit as the visitors managed to take a 6-1 lead into the fourth inning. Notre Dame responded with three runs in the fourth to tie the game, and continued with three more in the fifth inning to take a 9-6 lead heading into the sixth inning. After Keystone notched two runs, the Gators posted two runs of their own to claim their record-setting victory. In the nightcap, **Miller** claimed the school's stolen base record, finishing her rookie campaign a perfect 18 of 18 in stolen base attempts. During the week, junior **Brea Kehr** led the Gators with runs on nine hits, including two doubles and finished the week with four runs batted in. **Miller** added five runs on five hits with a triple and four RBI's while junior **Tawny Cevora** chipped in with four runs. Junior **Colleen McCauley** paced the team with five RBI's and added two doubles. Junior **Marylu Ortiz** contributed four RBI's and six hits to the effort. In the pitching circle, **Cevora** led the team with 13 strikeouts in 17.2 innings.
