Rosemont - So - Attack

Licata scored seven goals to tie his own program record on Saturday, scoring four straight goals in the third period to erase his team's four-goal deficit, and to help Rosemont earn their program's first men's lacrosse conference win in a 13-12 decision against Immaculata. Licata's final goal of the afternoon gave Rosemont its first lead of the game.

Gwynedd Mercy - Jr - Attack

Belardo totaled 13 points (4G, 9A) in two CSAC wins this week. Against Rosemont, he tallied three goals and four helpers. Two goals came on the man-up, while adding five groundballs and three caused turnovers. In Saturday's win, he tied a career-high with five assists, and also tallied once in a 17-9 victory over Centenary.

COREY ELMER

Cabrini - Sr - Attack

Reinholds, Pa./Conrad Weiser

Elmer etched his name in the Cabrini history book today, as the senior tallied a record 13 points in the win. Elmer also tied program records with seven goals and six assists in the win. Elmer's 13 points give him 209 for his career, making him just the seventh player in program history to surpass the 200 career point plateau. He now stands sixth on Cabrini's all-time points, fourth in goals with 113 and fourth in assist with 96.

AROUND THE CSAC



CABRINI COLLEGE
10-0, 2-0 CSAC

Cabrini improved to 10-0 with Saturday's 18-8 win at Marywood. Senior **Corey Elmer** set a program record with 13 total points and tied records with 7 goals and 6 assists. **Elmer** either scored or assisted on 11 of Cabrini's 14 first half goals. The senior also became the seventh player in program history to surpass the 200 career point plateau. Cabrini will host Neumann on Wednesday before visiting No. 2 Salisbury on Friday night.



CENTENARY COLLEGE
3-6, 1-1 CSAC

Centenary went 1-1 on the road in CSAC action last week, defeating Immaculata 12-8 before falling at Gwynedd Mercy. Sophomores **Anthony Biango** and **Trevor Krupinski** both recorded four points during the win over Immaculata. The Cyclones outscored the Mighty Macs 6-1 during the final 17 minutes to earn the win. Sophomore goalkeeper **Kevin Switzer** made 47 saves in two games, including a season-best 25 at GMU.



GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY
7-3, 3-0 CSAC

Seven different Griffins found the back of the net as Gwynedd Mercy picked up a 14-5 win over Rosemont on Wednesday. Junior **Nico Belardo** led the charge with seven points on three goals and four assists. Senior **Mason Risner** netted five goals and added an assist while sophomore **Tommy Belmont** chipped in two goals and three helpers. In Saturday's 17-9 win over Centenary, the team took time to honor its seniors: **Risner**, **Anthony Scardina**, and **Mark Vattilana**. Sophomore **Tony McCraw** along with **Risner** would total four goals and an assist apiece. **McCraw** also won 19-of-28 faceoffs while totaling a team-high 16 groundballs and five caused turnovers.



IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY
0-10, 0-3 CSAC

Immaculata dropped conference contests to Centenary (12-8) and Rosemont (13-12) last week. **Bhelly Bagbonon** led the Mighty Macs during the week with six goals and six assists. **Rocco Piliero** recorded five goals and two assists, and **Michael Thompson** had four goals and one assist. Immaculata will be home for both contests this week hosting Gwynedd Mercy and Marywood.

AROUND THE CSAC



Marywood went 1-1 in conference matchups this week, posting a win over Neumann before falling to No. 3 Cabrini. Marywood scored 12 consecutive goals to avert early struggles to down Neumann 15-9 Wednesday. **Riley Dobel** led with five goals and two assists for seven points. **Brandon Terlizzi** added three scores. **Michael Squillante** was phenomenal at the faceoff circle, winning three-fourths (18 of 24) of his faceoff chances and picking up seven ground balls. The Pacers stood toe to toe with Cabrini for 15 minutes in an 18-8 loss to the Cavaliers. Marywood matched its program high of eight goals against the Cavaliers. **Scott Slater** led with three goals and an assist for four points. **Dylan Swope** matched him with four points on two goals and two assists. He is one assist short shy of the career record. Marywood hits the road this week at Susquehanna Wednesday and at Immaculata Saturday.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY
5-7, 2-1 CSAC

Neumann (3-8, 0-2 CSAC) split a pair of games this week. The Knights fell at Marywood 15-9 in CSAC action. **Ryan Eber** scored five goals for Neumann. **Chris Scott** added three goals. **Alex Becker** made 22 saves in net. Neumann then defeated SUNY-Canton 19-6 in non-conference action. **Eber** once again scored five goals. **Kevin Fonio, Patrick Rose** and **Scott** each netted three goals. **Scott** also added four assists. **Becker** made 10 saves in net. **Tom Blakeslee** added three saves in relief. Neumann is on the road this week for a pair of conference games, beginning at Cabrini on Wednesday and then Centenary on Saturday.



NEUMANN UNIVERSITY
3-8, 0-2 CSAC

Stephen Licata's four straight third-period goals lifted the Ravens from a four-goal deficit, and **Dean Grisoff's** decisive goal with nine seconds left in the game gave the Ravens a 13-12 win over visiting Immaculata on Saturday. **Licata** scored seven on the day, tying his own program record for the most goals in a single game. The win was the first conference win for Rosemont's men's lacrosse program. On Wednesday, Gwynedd Mercy got the better of the Ravens, 14-5. On Monday afternoon the Ravens host the Stockton Ospreys in a non-conference game, and on Wednesday evening the team will travel to play Centenary.
