CSAC HONOR ROLL

STEPHANIE FARRAR - Gwynedd Mercy - Sr - OF

Batted .500 (7-for-14) with seven RBI's five runs, two doubles and two triples with two stolen bases. She totaled a .929 slugging and a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage. In game one with Cedar Crest, she was 2-for-3 with three RBIs, two runs, a double and a triple. In game two, she went 3-for-4 with two runs and an RBI and a pair of SBs. In game two of a 5-3 win over Centenary, her three-run triple keyed a four-run fifth to help GM take a DH sweep. She finished 2-for-4 with two runs.

MARIAH RUNCO - Marywood - Jr - 3B/DP

Runco went 10-for-12 during the week at the plate with a slugging percentage of 1.333. She had two doubles, two triples and nine RBI as Marywood went 4-0 in CSAC action. She also had a .867 on base percentage and scored seven runs.

CSAC SOFTBALL NOTES

BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE DEFENDERS (3-10, 1-1 CSAC)



Having a break through week, the Lady Defenders went 3-1 in the first week in April. The team earned its first win of the season as they took one from Rosemont College, winning 5-4, giving pitcher, **Amber Kachelries**, her first win of 2014. On Thursday, the bats came alive for the Lady Defenders, as **Erica Thomson** and **Ashley Adams** both recorded 5 RBIs in their DH with Valley Forge Christian. Sweeping the series, BBC won 9-4 and 13-10. With the victories, **Coach Higley** is just three wins away from reaching the 200 career win mark. It will be a busy week for BBC as they host Immaculata Monday, travel to Cedar Crest Tuesday, welcome Centenary Friday, and play at Neumann Saturday.

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (9-10, 9-3 CSAC)



The Cavaliers posted a 5-3 week to improve to 9-10 overall and 9-3 in the CSAC. The Blue and White dropped a pair of games to Eastern on Monday, before sweeping Keystone and Cedar Crest. Cabrini split a doubleheader with Neumann on Saturday, snapping a 17 game losing streak against the Knights. Four Cavaliers recorded at least 10 hits last week, led by 16 off the bat of freshman **Lindsay Savar**. The Cavaliers will step out of conference play this week to face Arcadia on Tuesday and host Delaware Valley on Thursday. They return to CSAC action on Saturday when they visit Marywood.

CAIRN UNIVERSITY HIGHLANDERS (8-9, 3-7 CSAC)



The Highlanders had a rough week of games against conference rivals, Neumann University, Keystone College and Marywood University. Cairn struggled to put runners on base on Wednesday afternoon against Neumann, losing 0-11 and 0-9. On Saturday the Highlanders were able to grab a win against Keystone College as they split their doubleheader, 3-2 and 3-13. **Tiffany Gower** helped lead Cairn to victory as she pitched all seven innings, allowing just five hits and making only two errors. On Sunday, Cairn traveled to Scranton, PA for a doubleheader against Marywood University. The Highlanders were shutout as the Pacers won both games, 0-8 and 0-8. The Highlanders look ahead this week as they host two non-conference doubleheaders against Penn State Hazleton and Eastern University this Tuesday and Wednesday. They will then travel to Immaculata University on Friday afternoon and to Centenary College on Saturday.

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (0-16, 0-8 CSAC)



The Falcons finished 0-4 this week dropping a double header first to Gwynedd-Mercy (10-0, 12-0) then falling to Cabrini (9-1, 8-0). The Falcons will play host to several CSAC teams this week including Rosemont, Baptist Bible, and Notre Dame (MD). Offensive leaders for the Falcons include two upper classmen **Shannon Wenner** who is batting .417 with 15 hits and two doubles, and **Javara Troupe** who is batting .302 with 13 hits and 1 double, and a triple.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (4-18, 4-5 CSAC)



Centenary saw its three-game winning streak come to an end with losses in all eight of its games last week, including four against CSAC foes. Senior shortstop **Katie Ciecwisz** recorded five hits against King's to move into fourth place all-time at Centenary with 142. She also ranks in the top 10 in games played, runs scored and RBI at Centenary. Centenary plays five games next week, all against league competition.

GWYNEDD MERCY UNIVERSITY GRIFFINS (6-11, 6-0 CSAC)



Gwynedd Mercy picked up four CSAC wins to stay unbeaten in conference play. On Wednesday, they took two from Cedar Crest, 10-0, and 12-0. On Saturday, the Griffins scored 8-0 and 5-3 wins over Centenary. Sophomore **Ashley Lamont** did it with the bat and on the mound. She would go 6-for-12 with five RBI's at the plate and go 4-0 with no earned runs, 21 K's and just three walks in four starts. Senior **Stephanie Farrar** also batted .500 (7-for-14) with seven RBI's, five runs, two doubles, and two triples.
