The squad opened the week on Tuesday hosting CSAC rival Rosemont College, and despite a late rally, was unable to defeat the Ravens as the Gators fell 4-3. The team then rebounded by jumping out to an early 9-5 first half lead at Bryn Athyn on Wednesday and continued their hot shooting as by adding seven goals in the second half for a 16-8 victory. The Gators concluded the week by travelling to CSAC foe Centenary College in a game the Gators jumped out to an early 7-1 lead and an 11-8 halftime advantage. Unfortunately, the hosts got hot to start the second half to go on a 10-1 run to gain an 18-12 lead with under ten minutes remaining. Notre Dame again made a late run, notching five more goals over the final eight minutes but it wouldn't be enough as the Cyclones claimed the contest 20-17. **Sawyer Butto** paced the Gators with 16 goals for the week and two assists. **Brittany Peddicord** added 10 goals and an assist while grabbing 10 groundballs and causing six turnovers. **Michaela Olson** led the team with 16 draw controls.
