## CSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK



**LIZ COYNE**  
**Rosemont College**  
**Sr. - F - West Chester, Pa.**

Coyne registered the 1,000th rebound of her career, becoming just the sixth CSAC women's basketball player ever to record

1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds. For the week Coyne earned double-doubles in all three games played, running her streak of doubles-doubles to five straight (11 for the season). For the week she averaged 22.7 points and 12.3 rebounds per game. She was put on the line for 25 shots, sinking 20 (.800) for the week.

## CSAC HONOR ROLL

### NORA JOYCE

**Marywood University - Sr. - G**

Joyce scored a career-high 24 points in a 75-63 win vs. Neumann Saturday. Joyce made 11 of 18 shots against the Knights. She added eight points in a win over Cedar Crest. Joyce shot 57.6 percent from the field for the week.

### MEGAN DECKER

**Cabrini College - Sr. - G**

Decker averaged 14.3 points and 10 rebounds to lead Cabrini to a 3-0 week. In a win vs. Centenary she had 12 pts, nine rebs and seven assists. She added 11 ps, 10 rebs, five assists and three steals as Cabrini took sole possession of first place in the CSAC with a 71-40 win over Immaculata. Decker was the key in a 61-52 win at Neumann, scoring a career high 20 pts to go with 11 rebs.

## AROUND THE CSAC

### BAPTIST BIBLE DEFENDERS (1-13, 1-7)

BBC went 0-3 on the week, as they struggled away from home. At Rosemont College on Monday evening, the Lady Defenders were handed a 25-86 loss. The team took a break from conference action and headed to the University of Valley Forge on Wednesday, and despite 22 points from **Callie Kitowski**, the team ended up on the losing side of a 54-68 contest. To end the week, BBC traveled to Immaculata and lost 31-91. The Lady Defenders play only twice this week, hosting Gwynedd Mercy University on Wednesday at 6:00pm and traveling to Cabrini College on Saturday for a 2:00pm showdown.

### CAIRN HIGHLANDERS (2-11, 0-7)

The Highlanders played one game this past week when they hosted Bryn Mawr College on Monday. The Owls secured their first win of the season with a 44-35 win over Cairn. The result pushed the Highlanders to 2-11 this season. Cairn will play this Wednesday at Marywood University and will host Centenary College this coming Saturday.

### CENTENARY CYCLONES (4-13, 3-5)

The Centenary women's basketball team fell to Cabrini (90-55) early in the week before defeating Keystone College with a late second half rally (69-62). The Cyclones are now 4-13 overall and 3-5 in league play. Centenary's **Mallory George** led the offense with 32 points on 9-27 shooting from the field and 14-19 from the stripe while also cleaning up 18 rebounds off the glass. Sophomore **Melissa Rabe** added 23 points and 18 rebounds on the week with three blocks. The duo combined for 23 points in the second half of the comeback win over Keystone College. Centenary will welcome Cedar Crest College January 28th @ 6:00pm while hosting our annual Pink Game for Breast Cancer Awareness.

### IMMACULATA MIGHTY MACS (10-7, 7-1)

Immaculata went 2-1 in CSAC play this week to remain alone in second place in the conference. On Monday, the Mighty Macs earned a tough 77-71 road victory at Gwynedd Mercy behind 23 points from **Sara Smith** and a career-high 17 points from **Mackie Fitzgerald**. The Mighty Macs used a second half run to put them up by 14 as they held on the rest of the way. On Thursday night, IU took their first CSAC loss of the season, a 71-40 defeat at the hands of Cabrini. **Brittany Merkle** led the Mighty Macs with 14 points and six boards. On Saturday, Immaculata started the game on a 26-0 run as they hosted Baptist Bible and they ended up winning 91-31. IU had four score in double digits, led by **Lindsay Cras** with 12 points. **Meghan Gallagher** chipped in with a career-high 11 points off the bench. This week, the Mighty Macs will play two road games at Keystone on Wednesday and at Marywood on Saturday.

### CABRINI CAVALIERS (15-3, 9-0)

The Cavaliers improved to 15-3 and a perfect 9-0 in the CSAC with a trio of wins last week that pushed their current win streak to nine. Senior **Amber Keys** scored a career high 27 points in 26 minutes to lead four Cavaliers in double figures in Monday's 90-55 win over Centenary. On Thursday, Cabrini handed Immaculata its first CSAC loss, topping the Mighty Macs 71-40, as **Keys** and **Megan Decker** posted double-doubles of 17 points, 12 rebounds and 11 points, 10 rebounds, respectively. On Saturday, the Blue and White gave head coach **Kate Pearson** her 100th victory in a 61-52 win at Neumann. **Decker** led Cabrini with a career high 20 points to go with 11 boards in the win. Cabrini will look to continue its streak on Wednesday as it visits Rosemont before hosting Baptist Bible on Saturday.

### CEDAR CREST FALCONS (3-12, 2-5)

The Cedar Crest College basketball team did not play any games this past week due to weather. The Falcons will play numerous CSAC games this week including Marywood 1/26, Centenary 1/28 and Rosemont 1/31.

### GWYNEDD MERCY GRIFFINS (10-7, 6-2)

The Griffins were 1-1 last week, falling in a tight 77-71 decision to Immaculata Monday before rebounding with an 88-66 home win over Rosemont Saturday. Wednesday's game with Marywood was postponed to Monday, Feb. 9. In Monday's game, **Natasha Matthews** scored her 1,000th career point en route to a 16-point, 11-rebound performance for her fifth double-double on the season. **Olivia Bradford** added 17 points while **Chandler DiFebbo** pulled down a career-high 12 rebounds. In Saturday's win, **DiFebbo** had another personal best, this time netting 19 points while shooting 8-of-9 from the floor. **Bradford** would score another 17 points. The Griffins play at Baptist Bible on Wednesday in their only action for the week.

### KEYSTONE GIANTS (8-8, 5-2)

**Alyssa Cuomo** became just the eighth player in program to reach the 1,000-point plateau on Wednesday night against Centenary, but the Cyclones outscored the Giants 19-2 over the final 5:24 to claim a 69-62 win. **Cuomo** finished with a game-high 21 points and added a team-best nine rebounds while **Ashley Evans** (12) and **Jazmyn Robinson** (10) also finished in double-figures. **Robinson** dished out a game-high eight assists while **Chelsey Hropovich** blocked four shots with **Jerica Rode** adding three blocks. Keystone will host Immaculata Wednesday night before traveling to Notre Dame of Maryland on Saturday afternoon.

## AROUND THE CSAC

### MARYWOOD PACERS (10-5, 5-2)

Marywood won a pair of CSAC games this week to improve in the conference standings. Trailing by as many as 15 points in the first half, the Pacers went on a 19-point run to down Neumann 75-63 on Monday. **Nora Joyce** scored a career high 24 points. **Ashley Murray** sparked the comeback with all 17 points coming in the first half. The Pacers handed Notre Dame (Md.) a 71-33 loss Saturday. **Danielle Terranella** was the lone player in double figures with 14 points. **Maggie Presnal** secured eight boards in both games. Marywood has three CSAC games this week, traveling to Cedar Crest Monday before hosting Cairn and Immaculata Wednesday and Saturday, respectively.

### NEUMANN KNIGHTS (7-10, 4-4)

Neumann dropped both conference games this week. On Monday, the Knights fell to Marywood by a 75-63 score. **Jessica Schlesman** led the Knights with 18 points and five assists. On Saturday, Neumann lost to Cabrini 61-52. Four Knights scored 10 points each to lead the Knights and **JoHanna Metzger** netted a double-double. Neumann will host conference foe Notre Dame of Maryland on Wednesday for its lone action of the week.

### NOTRE DAME GATORS (5-12, 2-7)

Notre Dame was 1-1 this week with one game cancellation due to inclement weather. The Gators opened the week with a 60-49 win over Valley Forge. Freshman **Zaria Comer** recorded her sixth double-double of the season with 17 points and 11 rebounds, while **Allyson Whitacre** added 15 points and team season high, seven assists. Bad weather forced a game cancellation Wednesday against local rival Trinity University. Saturday, the Gators traveled to Marywood for their first of two games this season, but fell to the Pacers 71-33. Notre Dame will face off against Neumann University Wednesday and Keystone Saturday in the upcoming week.

### ROSEMONT RAVENS (7-10, 3-5)

The Ravens extended their winning streak to four games this week before Gwynedd Mercy took a decision against the Ravens on Saturday. **Liz Coyne** would earn a double-double in all three games this past week, giving her 11 for the season. On Monday Rosemont romped over Baptist Bible. **Coyne** led the Ravens, scoring 23 with 10 rebounds. **Jasmyn Parker** scored a career-high 14 against the Defenders. Wednesday the Ravens had no problem defeating Bryn Mawr in a non-conference game. **Coyne** again scored 23. Her 15th rebound of the night was her 1,000th career rebound. Back in action on Saturday despite **Coyne's** 22 points and 12 rebounds the Ravens were beaten at Gwynedd Mercy. This coming week the Ravens host Cabrini on Wednesday night and Cedar Crest on Saturday afternoon.
