## CSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Bradford had an outstanding week, helping her team to two big CSAC wins. She started the week by flirting

with a triple double against Keystone, going for 24 points, nine rebounds and eight assists. She would score 18 of her 24 points in the second half to help open up a three-point halftime lead. Saturday saw her go for 27 points and 11 rebounds, both career highs in the win at Neumann. Again she would save her best numbers for the second half, scoring 18 points to break open a tie score at the half. She averaged 25.5 points and 10 rebounds for the week while shooting .679 from the field.

## AROUND THE CSAC

### BAPTIST BIBLE DEFENDERS (1-18, 1-12)

The Lady Defenders went 0-3 on the week, including a close loss to Cedar Crest College on Wednesday. BBC held a two-point lead at the half, but a late 12-0 run by the Falcons in the final five minutes of play proved to be fatal for BBC. On Thursday, BBC hosted Marywood University and fell 27-64. To round out the week, the Defenders hosted Rosemont College and came up short, 32-82. The team will play their final two home games of the season this week, as they travel to Cairn University on Wednesday for a 7:00 game and then travel to Notre Dame on Saturday for a 1:30 match-up.

### CABRINI CAVALIERS (19-3, 13-0)

The No. 25 Cavaliers extended their win streak to 13 games with a pair of victories last week that improved the Blue and white to 19-3 overall and 13-0 in the CSAC. All 13 players in uniform marked the scoring column in Monday's 102-32 win at Cairn. Senior **Amber Keys** led the way with 17 points in 12 minutes, while classmate **Megan Decker** added 13 points and four steals in nine minutes. On Saturday, the Cavaliers topped Cedar Crest 83-40 behind 14 points each from juniors **Dana Peterson** and **Megan Martin**, while **Keys** paired 12 points and six boards. The Blue and White will host Neumann Wednesday before closing the week with a trip to Immaculata.

### CAIRN HIGHLANDERS (2-16, 0-12)

The Highlanders dropped three games this week in CSAC action. Cairn lost to Cabrini on Tuesday 102-32, Immaculata on Wednesday 81-33 and Cedar Crest on Friday 58-40. The results moved the Highlanders to 2-16 overall and 0-12 in the conference. Cairn will next host Baptist Bible on Wednesday, Feb. 11.

### CEDAR CREST FALCONS (5-16, 4-9)

The Cedar Crest College basketball team finished this past week 2-2 in CSAC competition downing Baptist Bible 57-48 and Cairn University 58-40. The Falcons did fall to both Cabrini and Marywood to finish the week at .500. Senior **Breonna Lewis** continues to lead the Falcons in scoring averaging 12.1 points per game and classmate **DeJanet Lantion** is averaging an even 8.0 points per game. This next week the Falcons will host Keystone College (2/9) and Notre Dame (MD) (2/11) and then travel to Gwynedd-Mercy University on the 14th.

### CENTENARY CYCLONES (7-14, 6-6)

Centenary split a pair of CSAC contests last week, defeating Notre Dame, 69-26, and dropping a close 67-60 decision at Neumann. **Mallory George** had the hot hand versus the Knights, knocking down 10-of-18 from the floor for a game-high 26 points. Three Cyclones reached double figures versus the Gators, led by **Kim Osieja's** 14, as 11 players scored at least one basket in the win. Centenary is slated to host Immaculata Monday and travel to Rosemont Saturday.

### GWYNEDD MERCY GRIFFINS (13-7, 9-2)

The Griffins picked up two big CSAC wins last week, defeating Keystone Wednesday, 90-79, and Neumann on the road on Saturday, 85-77. Junior **Olivia Bradford** had a large hand in both victories. She would flirt with a triple double Wednesday, going for 24 points on 9-of-14 shooting, nine rebounds, and eight assists. She would score 16 of her 24 points in the second half, to help break open a three-point halftime lead. **Bradford** capped the week with a career-high 27-point and 11-rebound performance again saving her best numbers for the second half where she would total 19 points to help pull away from a tie score at the break. This week, Gwynedd hosts Marywood Monday, plays at Immaculata Wednesday before welcoming Cedar Crest on Saturday.

### IMMACULATA MIGHTY MACS (13-7, 10-1)

The Mighty Macs won their only game this week, 81-33, over Cairn. They started the game on a 21-3 run and never looked back. They had 14 different players score in the game, led by 14 from **Sara Smith** and a career-high 12 from **Meghan Gallagher**. **Lindsay Cras** and **Emily Bell** had nine points and freshman **Theresa Walsh** scored a career-high eight points. The Mighty Macs have a big week coming up as they can clinch a playoff berth tonight at Centenary before hosting Gwynedd Mercy on Wednesday and Cabrini on Saturday.

### KEYSTONE GIANTS (10-11, 7-5)

On Monday at Neumann, **AAliya Hayes** scored a game-high 23 points while **Alyssa Cuomo**, **Cierra Hensley** and **Jazmyn Robinson** all recorded double-doubles as the Giants took the Knights to overtime, but Neumann prevailed 102-96 in a high-scoring affair. Keystone dropped a 90-79 decision on Wednesday at Gwynedd Mercy despite having five players reach double-figures in scoring with **Hensley** finishing with a game-high 14 rebounds against the Griffins. On Saturday, the Giants earned a key, 83-69 win at Marywood, with **Robinson** leading all players with 23 points and seven assists in the victory. Keystone will play three CSAC games this week, visiting Cedar Crest on Monday before hosting Rosemont and Cairn on Wednesday and Saturday, respectively.

## AROUND THE CSAC

### MARYWOOD PACERS (13-7, 8-4)

Marywood finished the week by taking two of three conference games. The Pacers started off by downing Cedar Crest 70-39 Tuesday. **Nora Joyce** led the team with 13 points, and **Catie Nealon** followed with 12. Marywood topped Baptist Bible 64-27 on Thursday. **Danielle Terranella** was the lone player in double figures with 10. The Pacers capped the week with an 83-69 loss to Keystone. **Maggie Presnal** finished with 17 points and eight rebounds to lead the Pacers. **Terranella** posted 13 points. **Maddie Lavery** blocked four shots and added 12 points. Due to school cancellation, the women's basketball game at Gwynedd Mercy is temporarily postponed. The Pacers host Lebanon Valley Wednesday and travel to Neumann Saturday.

### NEUMANN KNIGHTS (10-11, 7-5)

Neumann went 2-1 conference games this week, all at home. Tuesday, the Knights defeated Keystone 102-96 in overtime. **JoHanna Metzger** led the Knights with 21 points and 15 rebounds while blocking four shots. **Lauren Legler** scored 21 points and brought down 10 rebounds. **Jess Schlesman** netted 19 points and **Sarah Roberts** added 17 points while both handed out 10 assists. **Emily Lyons** hit six baskets from three-point land for 18 points. On Wednesday, the Knights won a 67-60 decision against Centenary. **Schlesman** recorded a double-double with 23 points and 10 rebounds. On Saturday, the Knights fell to Gwynedd Mercy 85-77. **Schlesman** led the Knights with 25 points. **Metzger** recorded a double-double with 21 points and 12 rebounds. Neumann will travel to Cabrini for a conference match up before returning home to host conference opponent Marywood on Saturday.

### NOTRE DAME GATORS (5-16, 2-11)

The Gators opened the week against Rosemont Wednesday in their last of two matchups this season. Freshman **Allyson Whitacre** led the Gators with nine points, going 3-4 from the free throw line with four rebounds in the 77-43 loss to the Ravens. **Zaria Comer** tallied eight points while posting four blocks for the third time this season. On Saturday, the Gators traveled to Centenary. Freshman **Stephanie Roche** paced the Gators with 14 points, with two three pointers, going 4-4 from the free throw line while senior **Shaun De' Jones** notched a season-high seven rebounds in the 69-26 loss to the Cyclones. Notre Dame now travels to their last away game of the season Wednesday against Cedar Crest.

### ROSEMONT RAVENS (10-11, 6-6)

Wins over Notre Dame (MD) on Wednesday (77-43) and Baptist Bible on Saturday (82-32) stretched the Raven's current winning streak to three games. This coming week features two key CSAC games as the Ravens travel to La Plume, Pa. to face the Keystone Giants on Wednesday night and end the week with a home game against the Centenary Cyclones on Saturday. Coming into this week, senior forward **Liz Coyne** has scored 2,042 career points and needs 28 more to set the new all-time (CSAC/PAC) conference record for points scored in a career.
