The Blue and White tallied fourteen hits and nine Cavaliers earned an RBI in the win. In the nightcap, Cabrini freshman pitcher **Kaitlyn Hohman** earned the win. The freshman pitched four innings, allowed two hits and struck out three Highlanders. Senior **Steph Diegel** led the Cavaliers to victory, with three hits and two RBI. The Blue and White tallied 15 hits on the night, while two other Cavs earned a pair of RBI in the win. Cabrini will host Eastern at Cabrini Field tomorrow and Rosemont on Friday, before they face Immaculata on the road on Saturday.
