## AROUND THE CSAC



**CABRINI COLLEGE**  
6-5, 4-0 CSAC

Cabrini stayed perfect in the CSAC as it went 2-1 last week. Seniors **Lacie Doubet** and **Melissa Scanzano** combined for five goals and five assists, while sophomore **Katie Lasater** added four goals as Cabrini topped Neumann 14-4. The Cavaliers saw their five game win streak come to an end on Friday, as the club suffered a 14-13 loss to Rowan. **Doubet** tallied four goals, while **Scanzano** and fellow senior **Bree Thompson** added three goals each. Eleven Cavaliers scored on Saturday, as Cabrini scored a 17-1 win over Cedar Crest. Junior **Sarah Carzo** led the way with four goals and an assist, while **Scanzano** netted three goals. The Cavaliers will welcome Immaculata to Edith Robb Dixon Field on Wednesday.



**CEDAR CREST COLLEGE**

The Cedar Crest College lacrosse team fell 17-1 against the Cavaliers of Cabrini on Saturday. This week the Falcons are set to play Wilkes (3/30) and Gwynedd (4/1). The IU women's lacrosse team picked up a pair of big CSAC victories this week as they topped Gwynedd Mercy, 19-6, on Wednesday and followed that up with a 22-9 triumph over Rosemont to move their CSAC record to 3-1. IU started the week with a 15-10 loss at Neumann. The Macs led for much of the game until the Knights scored seven straight goals to put the game away. On Wednesday, IU scored 13 of the first 14 goals of the game to race out to a 13-2 halftime lead. IU had a balanced scoring effort as they had seven players with at least two goals. On Saturday, senior **Danielle Lopez** had a big game with five goals and three assists to help IU put away Rosemont. **Hannah Verrecchia** added four goals and **Allison Jakavick** had two goals and a career-high five assists. Immaculata will travel to Cabrini on Wednesday in their only game this week.

Rosemont opened their 2015 CSAC schedule with a 16-6 win at Centenary on Wednesday. The win by the Ravens snapped the Cyclones' six-game win streak against Rosemont that went back to 2007, and their first win over the Cyclones since 2003. On Saturday the Ravens fell to 1-1 in the conference after losing at Immaculata, 22-9. The nine goals scored by the Ravens were the most scored against Immaculata since 2006, and the 31 combined goals scored were the most ever scored by the two teams head-to-head in their series that dates back to 2000. This week the Ravens travel to Misericordia for a non-conference game on Monday. On Wednesday the team will host Notre Dame (MD) in their first game of the season at the Ravens Athletic Complex.
