

## REGULATIONS FOR CEMETERY DECORATIONS

Due to safety and maintenance concerns, all grave decorations not within the cemetery's guidelines will be removed

- All items left at a gravesite (this includes decorations, flowers, and solar lights) must be placed in Cemetery approved flower vases.
- The Cemetery will allow up to 3 in-ground vases on most adult-size graves.
- The Cemetery allows artificial or fresh-cut flowers.
- **ITEMS NOT ALLOWED AND WILL BE REMOVED:** Trinkets, Glass Vases, Candles, Shepherd Hooks, Decorative Crushed Stones, Border Edgings, Outlining Graves, Outlining Headstones, Metal Frames, Rocks, Fences, In-ground Plantings of Perennials, Trees, Bushes, Shrubs, or any other items deemed not Cemetery approved. These items will be removed and discarded.
- Grave decorations must not interfere with Cemetery operations or maintenance. Such decorations will be removed by Cemetery personnel.
- Decorations and flowers that have become unsightly or weathered will be removed by the Cemetery.
- Each year the Cemetery undergoes two area-wide clean-ups to prepare for the spring/summer and autumn/winter months, with those bi-annual clean-ups typically occurring on or around January 17th – 31st and October 1st – 15th. No decorations will be permitted during those dates. If you wish to save your decorations, be sure to remove them prior to the clean-up start dates. All decorations left on graves, mausoleums, niches during these clean-up periods will be removed and discarded.
- During an Observed Holiday (e.g., Valentine's Day, Mother's & Father's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July 4th, Halloween, Dia de Los Muertos, or Thanksgiving) decorating a grave up to 7 days before is allowed. Please note that all decorations will be removed 7 days after the observed holiday. For a special day of remembrance please notify the Cemetery office. Remember all decorations must be placed in Cemetery approved flower vases.
- During the Christmas Season decorations are allowed beginning on December 1st through January 17th.
- While Cemetery employees will take care not to damage any grave decorations, we regret that we cannot guarantee all decorations will remain free from damage or loss and we do accept responsibility for these occurrences.
