

Your safety is important to us! Please do not leave valuables in your vehicle, and keep your vehicle locked at all times when not occupied.

FUNERAL SERVICES - Visitors not attending funeral services are requested to remain away from an area where services are in progress.

FLOWERS - All flowers and other grave decorations are removed if they pose a safety hazard, impair our ability to properly maintain the grounds, or when they become unsightly. During the holiday periods listed below, flowers will remain from the Thursday preceding the holiday thru Thursday after the holiday. Easter • Mothers Day • Memorial Day • Independence Day • Veterans Day • Thanksgiving • Christmas and New Years Day.

PETS - No pets are allowed on the cemetery grounds or in any of the buildings. Service animals are permitted.

AUTOMOBILES - Automobiles shall not be driven throughout the grounds at a greater speed than ten miles per hour. Automobiles are not allowed to park or to come to a full stop in front of an open grave unless such automobiles are in attendance at the funeral. Rolling Hills is not responsible for items left in vehicles including loss from theft, vandalism or any other occurrence of missing property.

BICYCLES AND MOTORCYCLES - No bicycles or motorcycles shall be admitted to the Cemetery except such as may be in attendance at funerals or on business.

CHILDREN - Children under fifteen years of age shall not be permitted within the Cemetery, or its buildings, unless accompanied by proper person to take care of them and be responsible for their actions.
