If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff \$2295

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of service/tribute; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, secretarial and administrative expenses.

The fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT AND STAFF (Weekend Services – Additional \$500)

A. VISITATION AT THE FUNERAL HOME (PER DAY OR PORTION THEREOF; NOT TO EXCEED SIX HOURS)..... \$595

Our services include: visitation setup, use of the visitation room for one day, display of floral arrangements, supervision and attendance during the viewing, visitation or wake.

B. Funeral Service at the Funeral Home or Other Facility..... \$695

C. Reception Room..... \$395

Our services include: use of room within our facility for the family to host a reception. All food and drink is the responsibility of the family and depends upon mortuary availability. **No alcohol is allowed on premises.**

D. Memorial Service at Funeral Home or Other facility..... \$695

Our services include: coordinating the memorial service, supervision of the memorial service, staff to attend the memorial service, set up and use of facilities for memorial service.

E. Graveside Service..... \$595

Our services include: coordinating the funeral arrangements at the graveside, supervision of the graveside service, equipment and staff necessary to conduct the graveside service.

PREPARATION

Embalming..... \$795

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home.....\$2,095

This charge includes: transfer of the deceased to the funeral home, basic services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations and local transportation to the airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the remains.

This charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff and transfer of the deceased to the funeral home.

Immediate Burial \$2695 - \$14,483

This charge for immediate burial includes transfer of the deceased to funeral home, local transportation to the cemetery, necessary authorizations and basic services of staff. This Charge does not include the use of facilities and staff or any visitation or ceremony, public or private prior to burial.

Direct Cremation \$2095-\$11,465

This charge for a direct cremation includes transfer of deceased to funeral home, local transportation to crematory, necessary authorizations, basic services of the funeral director and staff, and refrigeration for up to 72 hours (\$95 per day thereafter). This charge does not include the crematory fee, disposition permit, or the Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA) fee. If you want to arrange an immediate cremation you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of heavy fiberboard.
