



FLAG FLYING HOLIDAYS

You should display the flag every day from sunrise to sunset, weather permitting. If you would like to display your flag at night, it must be illuminated. Be sure to display the flag on national holidays and these days of importance:

JANUARY

New Year's Day - Jan. 1
Martin Luther King Day
- Third Monday in Jan.

- Jan. 20 (Every 4 Years)

FEBRUARY

Lincoln's Birthday - Feb. 12
Presidents' Day (Washington's

Easter Sunday - Variable

Army Day - April 6
Jefferson's Birthday - April 13

MAY

Mother's Day - Second Sunday in May
Victory In Europe Day - May 8

Memorial Day** - Last Monday in May

JUNE

Flag Day - June 14
