1. Peter and Paul's Message

- a. Jesus Christ, forgiveness, blood, redemption are taught by both.
- b. Paul preaches the glory of the cross to Gentiles, without distinction, apart from the law, to be members of a new body, destined for heaven.

- b. Ye will be redeemed without money Isaiah 52:3 (50:1)
- c. He hath redeemed Jerusalem Isa 52:9 (with his blood)
- d. A man of sorrows Isaiah 53:3-4
- e. We like sheep Isa 53:6; John 10:1-2
- f. Innocent man bearing sins he was the Passover lamb Isa 53:10; Heb 9:25-28
- q. Justify many Isa 53:11-12; Matt 20:28; Mar 14:24
- h. Absent is the mystery: Israel is fallen, salvation sent to the Gentiles, by grace, apart from the law, to form a new body, destined for heavenly places.

 - ii. Jesus' blood for the New Covenant Heb 12:24
- c. Pilgrims...among the Gentiles 1 Peter 2:11-12

4. Peter preaches Isaiah's Suffering Servant

- a. Kingdom setting 1 Pet 1:4-5 (Acts 3:19-21)
- b. Redeemed without money 1 Pet 1:18
- c. Without spot (innocent) 1:19
- d. He bare our sins, we were healed 1 Peter 2:24-25; Heb 12:13

5. Peter preaches Isaiah's cornerstone

- a. A cornerstone in Zion Isa 28:16
- b. But unto *them* which disobey(unbelieving Israel) Psalm 118:22 1 Pet2:7-8
- c. But ye are a holy nation, a royal priesthood Exo 19:6 Isa 61:6
- d. Paul's cornerstone message Rom 9:31-32; Rom 11:11
