

# GRACE: A DOCTRINE LIKE NO OTHER

## THE UNIQUENESS OF GRACE DOCTRINE

"If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward: How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery;"  
- Ephesians 3:1-2

### 1. Salvation by grace is essential.

- a. Saved by grace through faith - Ephesians 2:8-9
- b. To him that works not, but believes - Romans 4:5
- c. The kindness and love of God - Titus 3:4-7
- d. While we were still sinners - Romans 5:8-9
- e. He was made sin for us - 2 Cor 5:21
- f. The preaching of the cross – 1 Cor 1:18

### 2. The opposite of grace is works (law)

- a. You are not under the law - Romans 6:14-15; 11:6;
- b. If a man do, he shall live - Lev 18:5; Deut 6:25
- c. Tithing: Will a man rob God? – Mal 3:8-9
- d. Do the commandments – Matt 5:17-22; Matt 19:16-21
- e. Faith is not enough – James 2:17-24; 1 John 2:29
- f. Unforgivable sin – Matt 12:31-32
- g. Church attendance – Heb 10:24-26
- h. Baptism – Luke 7:26-30; Mark 16:16
- i. Them that are under the law are under a curse - Gal 3:10

### 3. The dispensation of grace was a mystery

- a. Dispensation of the grace of God given to me - Eph 3:1-2
- b. Paul's gospel is not after man - Gal 1:11-12
- c. The wisdom of God in a mystery - 1 Cor 2:7-8
- d. They preached a gospel without the cross - Luke 9:1,6 & Luke 18:31-34
- e. They didn't know it at Pentecost – Acts 2:38 (44-46), 3:21
- f. Kept secret since the world began – Rom 16:25
- g. Not according to our works, but his grace - 2 Tim 1:9-11
