“And they shall eat those things wherewith the atonement was made, to consecrate and to sanctify them: but a stranger shall not eat thereof, because they are holy.”

- Exodus 29:33

1. God's Sanctification / God's Purpose

- a. Sanctification = to set apart for God's purpose. 2 Tim 2:21, 1 Thess 5:1-4
- b. The mystery of his will = all things in Christ – Eph 1:9-10
- c. The mystery was hidden wisdom ordained before the world - Eph 3:9, 1 Cor 2:7-8
- d. God's purpose for us in Christ before the world began - 2 Tim 1:9
- e. The mystery of Christ was revealed to Paul – Rom 16:25, Eph 3:1
- f. The mystery included a separate purpose – a new sanctification.
- g. Sanctification was part of Israel's purpose – Romans 9:4
- h. Gentiles were not sanctified, we were the dregs – Eph 2:12, Rom 1:28

2. Your Sanctification

- a. Your sanctification is a heavenly calling – Eph 2:6
- b. Your standing is different than your state / position (in Christ) vs. condition (in flesh).
- c. The cross does more for you than just a sacrifice for sins, it separates you – Rom 6-8
- d. Now you have a heavenly position and ministry in Him – Eph 2:6, 5:30, Phil 3:20
- e. You are his people today, his ambassadors, saints, not a nation – 2 Cor 5:20, 6:14-17
- f. Our affections and our duty is not to build a nation, but a body – Col 3:4

3. Sanctification for Israel

- a. God had a sanctified purpose for the earth – Gen 1:26-28, 2:15
- b. The sanctification of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob – Gen 17:7
- c. Their sanctified position was dependent on their condition. – Exo 19:10-14
- d. The sanctification of Israel - Lev 20:5-8, 23-24
- e. The sanctification of the priests in Israel - Exo 28:40-41, 29:32-33, Num 16
- f. The sanctification of the prophets – Jer 1:5, Isa 60:2-3, 61:6
- g. Future sanctification of Israel – Eze 36:23-28, 37:28
- h. Jesus taught conditional sanctification to Israel – Mat 3:11-12, 5:48
- i. The sanctification of the remnant – Luke 12:32, 1 Pet 2:9, Jude 1, John 1:11-12, 15:16
- j. The fruitless branches will be cut off – John 15:1-8

4. The Mystery and Sanctification

- a. The mystery is how God could sanctify (use for his purpose) ungodly people – Rom 4:5
- b. You have a position not dependent on your condition → it is crucified in Christ.
