AN EXAMPLE OF STUDYING YOUR BIBLE RIGHTLY DIVIDED

- 1. Start by collecting the dots about what God is doing.**
 - a. Read and evaluate God's operation through Jesus, Peter(twelve), and Paul
 - b. Start with who is the audience?
- 2. Audience:**
 - a. Jesus: Israel - John 1:11, Matt 15:24, Rom 15:8
 - b. Peter: Israel - Matt 10:5-6, Luke 24:47, Acts 2:22, Acts 11:19
 - c. Paul: Gentiles - Acts 22:21, 2 Tim 1:11, Rom 11:13, Rom 15:16
 - d. What was the content of their message?
- 3. Prophecy:**
 - a. Jesus: Prophecy - Luke 1:68-70, Luke 24:44-47, John 5:39
 - b. Peter: Prophecy - Acts 3:18-24, 1 Pet 1:10
 - c. Paul: Mystery - Rom 16:25, Col 1:25-26, Eph 3:4-9
 - d. OT was the law, but Jesus came to replace the law right?
- 4. Law:**
 - a. Jesus: Law - Matt 5:17, Matt 8:4, Matt 23:2-3, John 14:15
 - b. Peter: Law - Acts 2:46, 10:13-14, 10:28, Jam 1:25, 2:10-12
 - c. Paul: Grace - Rom 6:14, Rom 7:4, Gal 5:1-3
 - d. OT was for Israel, NT was for all.
- 5. Israel:**
 - a. Jesus: Standing - Matt 19:28, John 4:22
 - b. Peter: Stumbling - Acts 1:6, 3:19-24, 1 Pet 2:8-9
 - c. Paul: Fallen - Rom 11:11-12
 - d. What's most important is the gospel.
- 6. Gospel:**
 - a. Jesus: Gospel of kingdom - Mark 1:14-15, Matt 6:10, Luke 10:25-28
 - i. The cross - Matt 16:21, Luke 18:31
 - b. Peter: Gospel of kingdom - Luke 9:2-6, Acts 1:3, Acts 2:38
 - c. Paul: Gospel of the cross - 1 Cor 9:17, 1 Cor 1:17-18, 1 Cor 15:1-4
 - d. Jesus came to forgive sins... but how?
- 7. Forgiveness:**
 - a. Jesus: Conditional - Mark 11:24-26
 - b. Peter: Conditional - Acts 3:19, 5:31, James 2:13, 1 John 1:19, 2:9-12
 - c. Paul: Grace - Eph 4:32, Rom 4:5-7
- 8. Right Division - (Connect some dots)**
 - a. There is a clear similarity between Jesus and Peter's ministry
 - b. There is a clear difference with Paul's ministry
 - c. We now have the basis of rightly dividing the word of truth.
 - d. Now we can study further, why did God change his operation/ministry?
 - i. The answer is found in Eph 3:10
