MARKS OF A LOCAL CHURCH HOW TO KNOW ONE WHEN YOU SEE ONE

"Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample."

~ Phil 3:17

1. What Marks a Local Church?

- a. We are talking about the church locally, not the one church, or each member.
- b. A local church is the local gathering of members of Christ's body for ministry
- c. We are not talking about any church (Acts 7:38), but a Pauline church Phil 3:17
- d. What are the marks of a local church?
 - i. Beza only 1 preaching the word
 - ii. Calvin and Bullinger -2 preaching the word / administer the sacraments
 - iii. Belgic confession (reformed) 3 preach, sacraments, church discipline
 - iv. Catholic (Nicene) 4 one, holy, catholic, apostolic church
 - v. Mark Dever 9Marks / J.M Carroll *Trail of Blood* 10-11 Landmarks
- e. There are many imposters we should avoid 2 Cor 11:3-4, 13; Rom 16:17
- f. What does a properly functioning local church look like?

1. They meet together

- a. More than 1, meeting regularly, praying together, eat together, they are one.
- b. Some groups do not have an identity together in Christ or otherwise 1 Cor 1:10
- c. Not just a Bible study or class, but saints who care one for another 1 Cor 12:25

2. They have a Bible and believe it

- a. Christ, our head, communicates to us through his word 1 Tim 6:3, 1 Cor 14:37
- b. All scripture is inspired of God, and is needed for our faith 2 Tim 3:16, Rom 10:17
- c. The Bible translation issue is a matter of our authority being the Bible 1Thss 2:13

3. They rightly divide the Bible - 2 Tim 2:15

- a. Paul is the master builder of this dispensation Eph 3:1-3, 1 Cor 3:10, 2 Tim 2:7
- b. Failure to rightly divide leaves you with a kingdom nation Acts 3:21 v. Rom 16:27
- c. They are stewards of the mysteries of God 1Cor 4:1-2, Col 1:27

4. They work in ministry

- a. Churches are not community centers, concert halls, gymnasiums, or recreational.
- b. Not an entertainment venue, but a place where saints gather to do ministry
- c. Ministry is according to God's will 2 Cor 5:18, 1 Tim 2:4, Eph 3:9
- d. Ministry is personal, and not a spectator sport, not paying someone else to do it

5. They pursue purity

- a. Purity is pursued, abhors evil, avoids worldly traditions, no compromise, integrity
- b. This is the will of God for your life 1 Thess 4:3, 1 Thess 5:22
- c. The church does not meet people half way, but is clearly separate.
- d. It is not a gathering of unbelievers and believers, it is not mixed 2 Cor 6:14

6. There is proper order – Col 2:5

- a. Recognizes headship in the family, society, and church 1 Cor 11:1-2, Rom 13:1
- b. Paul set things in the church in order 1 Cor 14:40, Titus 2:5, 1 Tim 3:5

7. They edify each other

- a. The main function of the church gathering Eph 4:16, 1 Cor 14:12, 14:26
- b. Sometimes building requires we first demolish 2 Tim 4:2, Gal 6:1-2
- c. Warns, rebukes, reproves, restores, comforts, instructs-1Ths 5:14, Rom 14:1, 15:3
- d. The church should be equipping each other, not self-help, self-motivated pep talks
