WHEN THE BIBLE IS WRONG THE NECESSITY OF DISPENSATIONAL INTERPRETATION

"...But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully..."

1. Being Biblical

- a. Biblical def. ~ pertaining to the Bible, of or in the Bible, Bible times. Should we be?
- b. Is the Bible just a source for bookmarks facebook quotes, baby names, proverbs?
- c. People in the Bible were sinners! Bible times span millennia! Everyone is biblical.
- d. When the Bible prophecies about you, are you being biblical? Rom 1:18, Mark 7:6
- e. Is being biblical better? Which is worse, not using the Bible or using it wrongly? 2Co 2:17
- f. Live biblically for a year; "It's in the Bible"; "I use the Bible"; "I obey the entire Bible"
- g. Biblical is not always ≠ right, true, appropriate, binding, for you to obey or participate

2. When the Bible is Wrong

- a. Denial has always been there, but damage can be done by those that receive it -2Co 4:2
- b. If it must always record what is right ... it doesn't Gen 3:1, Job 2:9, John 18:38 (context)
- c. If it must always speak about America in 2018 ... it doesn't. (respecting time/history)
 - i. Ps 33:12 (135:4, 147:19-20), Isa 9:10, Jer 29:11, Mt 24:6-13, Acts 2:20, Rev 12
- d. If every promise of the Bible is to you ... they are not. (audience)
 - i. Gen 12:3, Lev 22:3-6, 2Chr 7:14, Ps 37:4, Pro 22:4, Mt 6:11, Jn 14:13, 1Jo 5:14
 - ii. Take what on our missionary journey? Luke 9:1-6? (22:35-36)
- e. If God must always do the same thing ... he doesn't. (God's will)
 - i. Judgement/Peace Nah 1:3-4 & Isa 19:5 & 35:6-7, Ro 4:5 Lk 2:14 v. 12:51
 - ii. Miracles John 1:50 v. 2Co 5:7; 1 Cor 1:22
 - iii. How many times do governors pray for rain? Jam 5:17-18
- f. If every instruction is for everyone to follow ... then it will fail. (application)
 - i. Heb 7:4-6,12 & Mal 3:8-910, Matt 19:17-21, Luk 12:33, Acts 1:8-9, Ja 4:13, 5:14
 - ii. Is your life biblical? Deu 32:46-47 & 1 Tim 1:5-7
 - iii. The devil himself quoted Bible Matt 4:3-11 Ps 91:11 was speaking of Christ
- g. If it must always speak the same thing ... which it doesn't. (contradictions)
 - i. Who do you obey: God or devils? Lev 11:8 v 1 Tim 4:1-4
- h. If there was never any further revelation ... which there was. (progressive revelation)
 - i. Before faith came... afterwards revealed... Gal 3:23, Heb 1:1, Gal 1:12
 - ii. Something ended Rom 10:4, Matt 5:17, 24:34 Acts 2:17 v 1 Cor 13:8
- i. If it does not mean what it says ... which it does. (non-literal reading)
 - i. Mark 12:31-32, 16:17-18 (Rev 8:10-11, 9:1-4), Jam 2:24

3. Not Enough to Be Biblical

- a. Not enough to be Biblical for God's word to stay true and work 1Th 2:13
- b. We must be <u>dispensational</u> → God does not operate the same way throughout; His instructions change; there is progressive revelation; all profitable but not all prescribed
- c. God is not wrong, people are. People can teach any wrong thing from the Bible.
- d. When you fail to rightly divide, you make the Bible wrong.
- e. When you fail to recognize dispensational change, you make the Bible wrong.
