## I FOLLOW PAUL, AND SO SHOULD YOU

## THE LORD JESUS CHRIST GAVE US AN APOSTLE

"Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting."

~ 1 Timothy 1:16

## **Don't Be Ashamed of Paul**

- a. "I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ" Rom 1:16
- b. We are accused prejudicially, "You worship Paul." "You make too much of Paul"
- c. #1 killer of grace churches = shame of Paul/grace 2 Tim 1:8, 12, 16, 2:15
- d. "I follow Paul" we should not be timid to express it, nor should all Christians
- **1) Scripture commands it –** 1 Cor 4:16, 11:1, Phi 3:17, 2 Th 3:7-9
- 2) The Lord Jesus Christ sent Paul John 13:20, Acts 9:15, 26:15-18, Gal 1:1
- **3) The Lord made him your apostle** Rom 11:13, 15:16, Eph 3:1, Gal 2:9
- 4) God commanded he be a pattern 1 Tim 1:1, 1 Tim 1:16
- **5)** The gospel committed to him 1Co 9:17, Gal 2:7, 2Co 4:3, 1Th 2:4, 1Ti 1:11
  - a. If you are saved, it is by Paul's "gospel of Christ" Rom 16:25, 1 Cor 15:1-4
  - b. Without Paul, there is no gospel of grace (60%) or Romans or Eph 1:12-13
  - c. Luther "true masterpiece...very purest gospel...learn it by heart...daily bread"
  - d. Something else was committed unto him: the mystery of Christ Col 1:25-26

## What Does it Mean to Follow Paul?

- 1) You receive the will of God through Paul's books Eph 3:2,Phi 4:9 (1Tim 2:4, 1Th 4:3, 5:18)
- 2) Your foundation is the one Paul laid 1 Cor 1:10, 3:10-11
- 3) Your church receives its identity & doctrine from him Eph 3:3, 1 Cor 12:13, 2 Tim 3:16
- 4) Your traditions and church order comes from him 2 Th 3:6, 1 Cor 11:34, 14:37-40, 1 Tim
- 5) You're faithful to understand and minister the mystery of Christ 1 Cor 4:1, Eph 3:4, 3:9
- 6) Speak abundantly about the grace and glory of the Lord Jesus Christ Acts 13:43, Gal 6:14
- 7) You elevate Christ above you, above all Col 1:18, 2:10, 2:19, Eph 1:20-23, Rom 16:27
- 8) You do not worship the messenger or elevate yourself Mt 3:11, Act 10:26, 14:15, Gal 2:11
- 9) You hold the word of God/grace as sufficient and complete Rom 3:4, 2Ti 3:16-17, Col 1:25
- 7) Tou note the word of God/grace as sufficient and complete Rom 3.4, 211 3.10-17, Col 1.2
- 10) You do not diminish the work of Christ by your works Gal 2:21, 5:2
- 11) Your private life and heart is like him Pray often and frequently 1 Th 5:17-18
- 12) Your way of life is like him walking after the Spirit Rom 8:1, Gal 5:16
- 13) Your manner of life from him longsuffering, charity, living godly by grace 2 Tim 3:10-14
- 14) You count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Phil 3:7-8
- 15) You are willing to spend and be spent in ministry to others 2 Cor 12:15, 1 Cor 9:22
- 16) Christ is the Saviour, Head, Lord, God, King you are not (neither is Paul).

Knowing the pattern Christ gave to us, we follow Paul, and so should every Christian.
