# SAVED AND SERVING

## THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN SALVATION AND SERVICE

"Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin."

## ~ Romans 6:6

#### 1. Can a Christian ...?

- a. People ask, "Can a Christian \_\_\_\_\_?" ...or... "Is it a sin to \_\_\_\_\_?"
- b. "Christian" seen as right, justified, strong; "not Christian" seen as wrong, weak
- c. Reality #1: we don't think we are wrong or weak, even when we are.
- d. Reality #2: we don't want to be associated with the wrong or weak.
- e. Reality #3: many confuse salvation and service ← wrong
- f. Example: "any real, true believer is going to [vote this way]" (MacArthur)
- q. Unashamed workmen discern between salvation and service

#### 2. Salvation is What Christ Did

- a. Can they? Of course, but are they really Christians? 1 Cor 6:12, 10:23
- b. Christian salvation = trusting the finished work of Christ Ro 3:26, 2Co 5:21
- c. It is by grace (God's work) through faith (not your work) Eph 2:8-9, Ro 4:5, Ti 3:5
- d. Salvation through belief not behavior. Essential salvation beliefs:
  - i. 1- Godhead -2- You are not God (sin) -3- Christ is God -4- faith in the literal DBR for your sins and justification unto eternal life freely received.

## 3. Service is What You Do

- a. Can they? Of course, but is it becoming Christian service? 1 Cor 6:12, 10:23
- b. Who serves God? More saved than are serving ... but more trying to serve than saved
- c. Christian service = your life and labour doing the will of God Rom 12:2
- d. We are saved to serve Rom 6:6, 12, 13, 16 (this is why the church exists)
  - i. Paul spends > 50% of his epistles talking about service Rom 14:16-18
  - ii. We have a job /mission /vocation /calling /ministry Gal 5:13,Col 1:9,Eph 4:1
- e. Service requires spirituality Spirit, spiritual understanding, growth, strength

### 4. What the Difference Means

- a. 1- Mercy and grace to all. All can be saved!!! 1 Tim 2:4
- b. 2- You can be saved and never serve the Lord ← Shameful. You should. Eph 2:10
- c. 3- You can do works for God and not be saved. ← Tragedy (2 Th 3:2, Ti 1:16)
- d. 4- Not everything Christians (saved) do is right, good, helpful, charitable, edifying.
- e. 5- Not all serve the Lord 1 Cor 5:5, Phi 2:21, Rom 16:18, Ti 3:3
- f. 6- Carnal Christians exist babes in Christ are carnal 1 Cor 3:1-4
- g. 7- There are weak Christians Rom 14:1, 15:1, Gal 6:1, 1Co 8:7-9,1Th 5:14
- h. 8- Ignorant brethren (saved) exist Rom 1:13, 11:25, 1 Cor 12:1, 1 Th 4:13
- i. 9- Grace comes before growth Titus 3:3-7
- j. 10- Non-essentials for salvation may be essential for service. 1 Tim 4:6
- k. Good workmanship: assuring salvation before judging service
