ABRAHAM'S SEED

WHY THE NATION ISRAEL HAD THREE FATHERS

"And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise."

~ Galatians 3:29

1. Galatians

- a. Is Abraham our father? How? Why? What do we inherit? What is the promise?
- b. Don't miss the forest for the trees Galatians is about how we are justified.
- c. Paul rebukes Peter on this point Gal 2:14-16
- d. <u>The conclusion</u>: it is <u>NOT</u> by circumcision (flesh), law (works), or Israel (covenanted)
 i. Gal 3:6-14 = how are we justified? → promise, Spirit, faith, Christ.

2. The Promises

- a. A promise received is what someone else does not all promises are the same.
- b. The lessons we learn from covenants are different from their details:
 - i. Abraham, faith Sarah, grace Isaac, promise Jacob, election.
- c. The promises given to the fathers land, seed, blessing, world Gen 12:1-3, Rom 4:13
- d. The promise in Galatians 3 is defined in Gal 3:2-6 = righteousness by faith.

3. 3 Fathers of Israel

- a. There were three fathers for good reasons: singular seed, many nations, bless world.
- b. Sarah had one child: Abraham had more. From this we learn Rom 4:1, Gen 25:5
- c. 0 =Number of fathers under the law of Moses
- d. 1 = Number of fathers that could be called Israel
- e. 2 = Number of fathers that were circumcised when they received the promise.
- f. Abraham had a unique blessing w/o circumcision, law, or Israel.
 - i. If Abraham were called Israel then no "many nations"
 - ii. If Isaac were called Israel then Israel would be the only recipient of promise.
 - iii. Jacob did not have a promise of many nations Gen 35:10-12
- a. All three fathers were needed so as to teach the lessons to Israel and to us.

4. The Seed of Abraham

- a. Multiplied seed was promised to all Gen 17:2, 22:17, 26:4, 24, 28:13-14, 35:11
- b. Galatians $3:15-20 \rightarrow$ The promised singular seed was fulfilled in Christ (not us)
- c. Galatians 3:16 "and to one" one father/son which excluded circumcision, law, Israel
- d. Galatians $3:21-26 \rightarrow Made$ children of God by faith in Christ.
- e. Galatians 3:27-29 → How we are Abraham's seed and heirs (because of Christ)
- f. Galatians 3:28 We are in Christ according to a mystery
- g. We are Abraham's seed, because Christ fulfills that promise and we are in him.
- h. We inherit the things of Christ not Abraham, according to promise (grace) not law, works, or covenants given to Israel. Romans 4:10-25
