## A STUDY OF THE REMNANT'S INTERACTION WITH PAUL

"And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;"

## ~ 2 Peter 3:15

## 1. A Changing Ministry

- a. The remnant ministry was eventually replaced by the ministry of the Body of Christ
- b. <u>Ministry with Jesus</u> Messiah identified, kingdom nigh, Israel divided.
- c. Ministry from Pentecost Holy Ghost given, kingdom offered, Israel first.
- d. Ministry among Gentiles Scatter among nations, kingdom rejected, Israel left behind
- e. Ministry after Paul Salvation to the nations, kingdom postponed, Israel fallen
- f. Not all kept up with the changes John 3:26, 30, Acts 15:1,5, 18:25, 19:3

### 2. The Remnant and Paul

- a. Some helped Paul preach Christ, some did not Acts 13:2, 15:22,27,32-41
- b. Notable remnant helps to Paul: Barnabas, John Mark, Apollos, Silas, Andy & June
- c. "How could the prophesied remnant help the apostle of the mystery fellowship?"
- d. 1st Not all did There were conflicts, but Paul tried to resolve them. 1 Cor 1:10-12
  - i. Paul rebukes Peter, chief apostle of the remnant (not Gentiles) Gal 1-2, 2:11
- e. 2<sup>nd</sup> There is a lot of agreement with Paul. Gal 2:9, 2Co 11:22-23,12:11-12, Act 15:4
  - i. Those in Peter and Paul's ministries were brothers in Christ 2 Peter 3:15
  - ii. Jesus Christ, cross/resurrection, wonders, sin, faith Acts 15:8-11, 1Cor 15:11
- f. 3<sup>rd</sup> Their ministry changed from kingdom now to kingdom in the future (agreed)
  - i. They learned Gentiles could receive the Spirit, not subject to law Acts 10-15
- g. 4<sup>th</sup> Not every Jew was a part of the remnant Rom 7:1,11:1, c14, 1 Cor 1:14, c8-10
  - i. Israel was fallen, but every saint needed to know their witness, hence MMLJ.
  - ii. Apollos was instrumental in many Corinthian Jews believing Acts 18:26-28
  - iii. Paul, as a Jew, ministered to Jews -1Co 9:20, 2Co 11:22, Phi 3:4-5, Rom 11:1
  - iv. The remnant knew the change from OT to the NT, so did Paul 2 Cor 3:6
- h. 5<sup>th</sup> Mystery truth fulfils the word of God Rom 3:21, Col 1:25, Gal 4:21, 2 Tim 2:7
  - i. Remnant & Paul did not need social distance, wear badges, debate Gal 6:16
  - ii. They did not need the mystery fellowship to be in Christ Jn 15:5, Rom 16:7

### 3. Together in One

- a. Remnant interaction with the Body explains many issues in Paul's early epistles
  - i. Divisions, 1 Cor 1:10-12, 7:18-19, circumcision, law, days, meats Rom 14
- b. Ministries of Peter and Paul were in different geographies and people Rom 15:20
  - i. Paul ministered in places where there were remnant brothers Rom 15:1-16
  - ii. The remnant was dispersed and divided -2 Pet 2:1-3, 1-3 John, Jude, Rev 1-3
  - iii. The remnant ministry died with them Acts 12:1-2; 2 Pet 1:14
- c. Remnant and Body are different, but both minister Christ: this is mystery Eph 1:10
  - i. What is in common to all is what we glory in: Christ crucified 1 Cor 10:16
- d. The rebellious remnant that ignored Paul created doctrinal problems lasting centuries
