RETHINKING THE SERMON

RECONSIDERING WHAT IS BEING SAID AND WHY

"So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading."

~ Nehemiah 8:8

1. Something Amiss

- a. What you hear in every church this morning is a sermon, homily, lesson, preaching.
- b. 'What did you get from the sermon?' What most don't get is scriptural understanding.
- c. <u>Sermon</u> ~def. a discourse on Scripture for the purpose of instruction or exhortation.
 - i. New definition 'a long tedious speech', 'moralizing of a nondoctrinal nature'
- d. Sermons are now pretexts for self-help, storytelling, leveraging God's help.
- e. The main pursuit has become personal application (i.e. 'what does it mean to me')
- f. Sermons should not have the objective of pleasing you, appealing to you, inspiring you, engaging you, giving you self-assurance, a 'fresh word', or serve as a pep rally.
- g. What good is a sermon if it does not appeal to me? It's time to rethink the sermon.

2. Missing Bible

- a. Bible? "follow Jesus on your journey' 'God writes your story' 'God laid it on my heart'
- b. The pulpit should cause people to understand scripture Neh 8:8
- c. 'Preach the word' 'hold fast the form of sound words' 2 Tim 1:13, 4:2-4

3. Missing Context

- a. 'Sermon' not mentioned in the Bible despite 'sermon on the mount'
- b. Modern sermon title: Making Calm out of Chaos Matt 8:23-27
- c. Context: Jesus ministers to Israel confirming promises Rom 15:8, Ps 107:23-30

4. Missing the Big Picture

- a. 'I know the thoughts that I think toward you' 'to give you hope and a future' Jer 29:11
- b. You are not the point. God has a purpose and a will. Preachers are supposed to explain.
- c. Charts can serve the function of giving understanding of the scriptures in context.
- d. God's will changes, unfolds, is fulfilled, resumes, and is revealed from beginning to end.

5. Missing our Pattern/Place

- a. A sermon is supposed to strengthen, furnish, edify, instruct, and exhort the church.
- b. We are warned against teaching other doctrines, wrong doctrine 1 Tim 1:3-7, 16
- c. If you don't know the pattern, then who is the church following? 1 Pet 2:9, 1 Cor 12:17
- d. If you don't know our place, then what is God doing today? Eph 3:1-2, 3:9
- e. Understanding is necessary for us to operate in this dispensation 2 Tim 2:7
- f. Not understanding in churches is a failure to give proper place to God's words rightly divided in sermons.
