## The Fall of Israel

And Their Future Rise

Rom 11:12 – "Now if the fall of them [be] the riches of the world, and the diminishing of them the riches of the Gentiles; how much more their fulness?"

- 1. In Romans 9, 10, and 11, Paul describes Israel is fallen
  - a. Israel's Fall Rom 9:31-33, (Isa 8:14-15), Rom 10:3, 16, 21
  - b. God's Secret Rom 11:11, 25
    - i. Fallen Israel = Salvation to Gentiles Rom 11: 12, 15, 28, 32
  - c. God will still save Israel Rom 9:25-26, (Hos 1:9-10, 2:23), 11:26-27, 29
- 2. Prophecy describes Israel's New Covenant and Future Rise
  - a. A new covenant and the power to follow it Jer 31:31-34 (Heb 8:8-12), Eze 36:24-28
  - b. God will raise the nation up Jer 23:5-8, Isa 61:1-4, Hos 6:1-2
  - c. Promise fulfilled salvation/kingdom come <u>Jesus conquers</u> Rev 19, <u>1000 years</u> 20:4, <u>the</u> new Jerusalem 21:1-3
- 3. What happened A brief history of Israel

- a. Israel's Fathers Promise: land, a nation, a blessing Gen 12:1-3
- b. Egypt God's deliverance of the nation Gen 15:13-14/Ex 12:35-36, 41
- c. Law/Covenant and Wilderness
  - i. Israel's law covenant and judgment for disobedience (Lev 26 and Deu 28)
  - ii. Law does not make the promise of none effect Gal 3:16-19
- d. Promise Land and Judges Israel disobeys and over and over, is judged Jdgs 2:14-19
- e. Kings and Split Nation (Hosea's time)
  - i. Kingdom forever for house of David 2 Sam 7:16
  - ii. Split: house of Judah and house of Israel (Ephraim/Samaria) 1 Ki 11:9-13
    - The origin of the Samaritans, a mixture of corrupted 10 tribes of Israel and eventually foreigners that moved into the area when Israel/Ephraim/Samaria was taken captive – 2 Ki 17:24
- f. Fall into Captivity
  - i. Judgment: Ephraim/Samaria/Israel and Judah/Jerusalem Hos 5:5, 9:13, 13:16
- g. Return for Judah then Silence from God
  - i. Daniel reads Jeremiah's book Dan 9:2 (Jer 29:10-11, 25:11-12)
  - ii. Ezra and Nehemiah detail the captives that return to Judah and Jerusalem
  - iii. Afterward, zip until John the Baptist Mal 3:1, Isa 40:3, Mk 1:2-3
- h. Jesus and the coming kingdom rejected Mt 21:42-44, 16:15-21
  - i. Samaritan: leper (Lk 17:16), Good (Lk 10:33), woman (Jn 4:9)
  - ii. Stephen's testimony against Jerusalem, scattering Acts 7:51-52, 8:1
  - iii. Philip to Samaria Acts 8:4-8
