Chart Lesson: Rightly Divided Inheritance

Introduction

- In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth (Genesis 1:1)
- God created mankind through Adam and Eve and placed them in the garden of eden where they lived in a perfect and glorious environment. They disobeyed God's instruction not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil (Genesis 2:17; 3:1-7). This brought sin, death and evil into the world (Romans 5:12).
- Because of this God made a plan to restore the heaven and earth to its former glory (Revelation 21:1)
- Despite the disobedience of Adam and Eve God decided to call out for himself a nation of people amongst a sinful world.
- That nation would come through Abram who was given promises from God (Gen. 12:1-3; Gen. 13:15-17)
- God finalizes this promise with Abram through a covenant (Genesis 15:5-21)
- Inheritance = "The reception of an estate by hereditary right, or the
 descent by which an estate or title is cast on the heir; as, the heir
 received the estate by inheritance." Webster's Dictionary 1828
 - Inheritance = the receiving of an estate by hereditary right or divine right. In scripture the inheritance God gives is glorious
 - Estate = land, home, personal possessions, Fortune, anything that someone has ownership of
 - Heir = the one who receives the inheritance (traditionally the firstborn)
- The covenants & promises given to Abraham, along with the promised inheritance, is eventually passed down to Isaac and then to Jacob (Genesis 28:1-4)
- Jacob was also given the name Israel (Genesis 32:28; Genesis 35:10). He had 12 sons that become the heads of the twelve tribes of Israel. These 12 tribes become the nation of Israel.

- The Nation of Israel's inheritance
 - Israel is God's firstborn and heirs of the inheritance of this promised land on earth (Exodus 4:22)
 - What right does God have to give the land of Canaan for an inheritance? (Exodus 19:3-6)
 - He calls Israel a people of inheritance (Deuteronomy 4:15-21; Exodus 32:11-14)
 - Moses -> Given the law at Mt. Sinai and this set more terms and conditions for Israel's inheritance (blessing and cursing **Deuteronomy** 11:26-28)
 - Before Israel entered into the promised land the Lord had Moses and Eleazar count the number of people in each tribe to split up the land inheritance (Numbers 26:1-4; Numbers 26:53-54)
 - Because of Moses disobedience Joshua led the nation of Israel across the river Jordan and began the conquest of the promised land (Joshua 11:23)
 - Joshua chapters 13-19 details the inheritance being divided up amongst the nation of Israel as they were making their conquest.
 - Israel settles into their land and they begin to desire a king. We are
 introduced to king David who is promised the kingdom on his throne as
 an everlasting covenant (2 Samuel 7:12-13)
 - David sings about the inheritance of the land of Canaan (1 Chronicles 16:8-18)
 - Ezekiel talks about the division of the land of their inheritance in Ezekiel
 47:13 through 48:28 (Ezekiel 48:29)
 - Jesus comes preaching the kingdom of heaven at hand and he speaks of those who will inherit the earth (Matthew 5:5)
 - The little flock gets the kingdom (Luke 12:32)
 - The nation needed to be reborn by faith in Jesus Christ as their messiah (John 3:3-5 Jesus tells Nicodemus that the nation needs to be born again)
 - Jesus speaks of eternal life on the earth in the kingdom (Matthew 19:16-24)
 - The disciples not only inherit eternal life. They inherit a special

seat on the earth (Matthew 19:25-30)

- Even peter and the disciples continue this theme of inheritance of the earth (Acts 1:7; 1 Peter 1:3-5; Hebrews 6:10-12; Hebrews 13:14)
 - Sounds eerily similar to what Jesus told His disciples (John 14:2-3; Revelation 21:1-3)
- The Inheritance of the Body of Christ
 - God interrupts this prophetic program by giving Paul the dispensation of the grace of God concerning the mystery of Christ (Ephesians 3:1-9)
 - According to this mystery dispensation given to the Apostle Paul you have been baptized by the Spirit into Christ (Romans 6:3; 1 Corinthians 12:13)
 - You are now part of a new creature (2 Corinthians 5:17; Galatians 3:26-28)
 - Jesus Christ is the firstborn from the dead (Colossians 1:18)
 - There is an inheritance that we have obtained according to the dispensation of the grace of God (Ephesians 1:3-14)
 - This inheritance is not on the earth (Ephesians 2:4-6; 1 Thessalonians 4:14-17)
 - We have been blessed with all spiritual blessing in heavenly places in Christ Jesus (Ephesians 1:3)
 - We are heirs and joint heirs with Christ (Galatians 3:29-4:7;
 Romans 8:15-17)
 - Heirs of eternal life (Titus 3:7)

Conclusion

- It is not until the Apostle Paul that you know that you are a people destined for heavenly places. Our inheritance as the body of Christ is different than that of Israel's.
- God's mystery will will be fulfilled (Ephesians 1:9-10)

- According to prophecy Israel inherits eternal life on the earth
- According to the mystery the Body of Christ inherits eternal life in heaven with a heavenly seat
- BOC -> Inherits heavenly seat and yet we are alive on the earth before we fully receive our inheritance
- Israel -> Inherits the earth and can still live in heaven while they wait for their inheritance
