

MISSING VERSES, MISSING WORDS

WHERE, WHY, AND DOES IT MATTER?

*"It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone
[but by every word of God]***."*

~ Luke 4:4

1. Missing or Added

- a. ***'Every word of God' matters, but 'every word' is not found in new Bibles → Luke 4:4
- b. "New Bible" referring to Bibles translated/updated within last 50-70 yrs. (KJ is 400+)
- c. Also "new" because of the new underlying text. Changed text = changed words.
- d. What's new is not just readability, words/verses are missing leaving errors and holes.
- e. A twisted sophomoric response is given, "*they were not removed, KJV adds them!*"
- f. If added, why verse numbers? Brackets? Errors? Yet, still absent from 1200-1800yrs.
- g. Translations differ not just method & readability, but in text and belief in what matters

2. What's Missing Matters

- a. Protesting too much → "No major doctrine is affected. No significant changes."
- b. John 7:53-8:11 – 12 verses bracketed. Note says 'not found' 'added' 'not in the original'
 - i. NIV translator says it doesn't add "anything to our knowledge of the Bible"
- c. Matt 5:22 – 'without a cause' matters or else Jesus sinned - Mark 3:5
- d. Matt 19:16-17 - Jesus is no longer 'good' in these passages.
- e. John 1:18 – "Son" changed for "God" suddenly it matches the JW NWT. 3:16, too?
- f. John 3:13 – "which is in heaven" is gone (omnipresence), Acts 15:18 (omniscience)
- g. John 16:10 - "my" removed disconnects Jesus from being of the Father. 16:16-17
- h. Luke 2:22 – "her" removed for "their" (ESV, NLT, NIV, NASV) Jesus impure?
- i. Luke 2:23 – "Joseph" changed to father, also 2:43 Joseph gone again, 2:49 'business'
- j. Luke 4:44 – Where is Jesus? Notes say Galilee, as does 4:14, 4:31, 38, 5:1. ← Error.
- k. Hosea 13:14 – Repentance removed, questions added → the verse says the opposite.
- l. Hosea 6:6 – Where is mercy? This has Jesus misquoting Hosea - Matt 9:13, 12:7
- m. 1Sam 13:1- RSV/ESV leaves a hole "...", then 'lived one year', 30, 40, 50? Acts 13:21
- n. 2 Sam 21:19 'the brother of' removed creates error (ESV, NASB). Note: may be original
- o. Mark 10:24 – 'for them that trust in riches' removed makes it difficult to enter.
- p. Mark 18:11, 23:14, Acts 8:37 - Multiple verses missing from the first 5 books of the NT.
- q. 1 Tim 3:16 – Who is manifest in the flesh if not God? Acts 4:27, 7:59
- r. Romans 8:1b is removed making the statement false in context about Spirit and flesh
- s. Col 1:14 – "through his blood" is removed because it 'repeats the same info as Eph 1:7'
- t. 1 Cor 14:34 – Whose women if 'your' is taken out? No wonder people have problems.
- u. 1 John 4:19 – "him" is removed changing the meaning of the verse.
- v. 1 John 5:7 – translator says "we don't need them to affirm the doctrine of the Trinity"
- w. Rev 21:24 – "of them which are saved" is gone opening the door to universalism
- x. Calvary, hell, Godhead, 'new testament', 'communion', damnation, devil, 'take eat' gone

3. You Must Decide

- a. This not about credentials, expertise, science, or even the devil. It's a matter of belief.
- b. Most choose a Bible or readability or trusting a wise teacher they enjoy, respect, admire
- c. You must choose to believe God preserved every pure word or every Bible has mistakes
