THE INFECTION OF FEAR

TREATING FEAR WITH FAITH AND THE LOVE OF GOD

"Many of the brethren in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear."

~ Philippians 1:14

1. Fear as a Spiritual Problem

- a. We are treating spiritual problems (sin) with God's word, faith, Jesus Christ
- b. Fear ~def. The anxious expectation of evil or perception of impending danger.
- c. Different kinds of fear: careful, worry, nervous, anxiety, afraid, dismayed, dread, terror
- d. Source? Circumstances feed it, enemies use it but it is within us, a spiritual infection.
- e. It need not be permanent. It is not a "disease" without a cure. Fear can be relieved.

2. The Function of Fear

- a. Fear not always bad. God made us with capacity to fear. Fear can preserve, motivate.
- b. Fear is necessary in battle, for protection, to avoid evil, to obey Pro 8:13, 16:6
- c. Fear makes your weakness clear. Before God is fear Lk 23:40, Rev 1:17, Eph 5:21
- d. Fear of the Lord is beginning of wisdom (spiritual medicine) Pro 1:7,9:10, Isa 11:1-3
- e. God made us weak to learn... to fear him, trust him, know him Pro 29:25, 2Co 1:9,7:1
- f. The function of fear is ultimately to bring us to a knowledge of God.

3. Fatal Fear

- a. Fear is easily and often corrupted, then it becomes sinful, destructive, and fatal.
- b. "fearful, and unbelieving" described as those that partake of the lake of fire Rev 21:8
- c. Fear can paralyze, cripple, stop you from doing good, shake and disturb unstable minds
- d. You cannot think right, you will not act right, it infects your spirit w/despair Heb 2:15
- e. Fear is sinful when it is ignorant, false, irrational, selfish, or leads to hurting others.
- f. Sinful fear makes you think of yourself more than others, evil is more powerful than all.
- g. Rom 3:14-18 Destruction and misery come from not having godly fear.

4. Without Fear

- a. "Fear not" "be not afraid", etc. over 100x in the Bible God wants to save, how?
- b. There is a "terror of the Lord", but God is also loving, gracious (through Christ Jesus)
- c. The enemy of fear is faith, trust, and the love of God (all found in Christ Jesus)
- d. Fear is overcome with trust. The spiritual cure for fear is His power, love, mind 2Ti 1:7
- e. Courage, bravery, fearlessness not innate, but is learned from duty, faith, hope, love.
- f. Why did the brethren gain confidence by Paul's bonds? Phi 1:14 (duty, faith, and love)
- with did the breather gain confidence by Faur's bonds: 111 1.11 (daty, faur), faur
- g. Fear directly attacks your faith (what you know of God) his grace is sufficient -2Co 12:9
- h. People fear trouble, affliction, distress, loss but with Christ Rom 5:1-5 is true.
- i. You no longer need be bound to fear if you are bound to God Rom 8:15
- j. The list of things less powerful than the love of Christ is everything you fear Rom 8:35
- k. You are weak, but he is strong. You are powerless, but he is powerful.
- I. You are condemned by sin, but he through Christ Jesus justifies ungodly sinners.
- m. Can we be inoculated against fear? No. Can we be removed from all fears? No.
- n. Can our spiritual immune system be stronger to combat fear when it arises? Yes!
- o. Walk in in what we know by the Spirit of God. Trust Jesus Christ. Love God.
