2 Timothy 3:10

Paul's Pattern

1. 3:10 - Paul's Pattern

- a. "but thou" Timothy not as one of these powerless greedy ignorant corrupt fools.
 - i. Their folly shall be manifest, but there is no folly in following Paul's pattern.
- b. "hast fully known" compare 'last days' to hast 'folly' to fully 'ever...never' to known
 - i. He already fully knew what was needed to be godly and perfect (2 Tim 3:5,3:17)
 - ii. A typical Christian thought is that God has not given them all they need.
- c. "my" If not a chosen vessel, pattern, apostle then Paul is just a venerated saint.
 - i. 'my gospel' 3x, 'given to me' 14x Don't make this you, Paul is still the pattern
 - ii. What follows is the antidote to 'what men shall be' in 2 Tim 3:2-4
- d. "doctrine" What prevents the powerless form that produces perilous times.
 - i. Always first in Paul's epistles Rom 1:16, 2 Tim 3:16, Eph 1-3, Col 1-3, 2 Tim 1-2
 - ii. Sound doctrine should be a church priority 1 Tim 4:6, 13, 16, Titus 1:9, 2:1, 2:7
- e. "manner of life" -Not his Jewish life, but new life -Ac 26:4, Rom,1Th 1:5,1Co 10:33, Phi 3
 - i. This is what happens in response to doctrinal truth working Gal 2:14, 1Co 15:33
 - ii. Jesus was not a sinner, Paul was, his doctrine deals with sin in him Rom 6-8
 - iii. Paul's pattern was not just in the gospel, but in his mind, heart, and life.
- f. "purpose" God given Acts 26:16, 2 Tim 1:9, eternal Eph 3:11, spiritual 2 Cor 1:17, 9:7
 - i. The affection, orientation, goal of 1 Tim 2:4 is unique to this dispensation (Paul)
- g. "faith" Faith of Christ, not works of the law strong in faith Rom 4:20, 1 Cor 16:13
- h. "longsuffering" What Paul calls his was a fruit of the Spirit Gal 5:22
 - i. Notice this list is the antidote to what 'men shall be' through the power of God.
- i. "charity" 22/29x is Pauline; 'bond of perfectness' Col 3:14, excels over gifts 1 Cor 13
- j. "patience" Waiting in peace. Continuing with contentment. Quiet endurance.
 - i. It works hope 1 Thess 1:3, Rom 5:3, 15:4
 - ii. Waiting for the will of God, growth, glory, justice 2 Tim 3:9, Christ.
