# Romans 8:35-39

## Inseparable from God's Love

#### 1. 8:35 – The Love of Christ

- a. "shall separate us" Speaks to standing in unity, communion, fellowship with Christ.
  - i. In contrast a covenant standing can be revoked Heb 6:4-8, 10:26-29
- b. "love of Christ" not our love for him, but his love 2 Cor 5:14, Gal 2:20
  - i. Love on display by his death, resurrection, dispensation of grace ch. 5-8
  - ii. The love of Christ is found in his grace freely given, freely received.
  - iii. There is a victory found in the abundant love of Christ (grace) Rom 5:21
- c. "Tribulation, distress..." Love naturally looks like peace, blessing, provision, safety.
- d. Trouble, poverty, danger could belie love, but not now with what we know 2Cor 11:23

#### 2. 8:36-37 – More than Conquerors

- a. Sheep lay down, get lost, bleat for their shepherd to intervene. They do not conquer.
- b. Psa 44 (13-17-22) is faithful Israel being destroyed, while God is silent.
  - i. They were shamed by claiming God's defense while being defeated.
  - ii. They need God's help, but where is he? Psalm 44:23
- c. Psa 44:22 says "Yea", but Paul says, "Nay", the Psalm does not describe us!
- d. Not having a Shepherd's physical deliverance makes some feel like sheep.
  - i. But we are not sheep, we have strength in weakness due to the grace of Christ.
  - ii. Instead of us dying for the Lord's sake, the Lord died for our sake = conqueror!
- e. "more than conquerors" because of the love of Christ we now know (by grace)
  - i. We are complete in Christ, freely access all spiritual blessings, delivered from condemnation, justified, glorified.

### 3. 8:38-39 - Inseparable

- a. "I am persuaded" He conquers by his conviction (faith) Col 2:2, Rom 4:21, 2Tim 1:12
- b. If you are not persuaded, faith is weak, you will feel separated from the love of Christ.
  - i. Let God be true! Rom 3:4; Read and believe the word of God! Rom 10:17.
- c. The list: each item can each separate from God's love in any other context but in Christ.
  - i. In any state, by any force, at any time, in any place, from any creature...
- d. "death... life" Death separates (it doesn't extinguish); life is mortal, vain, corrupt by sin
- e. "principalities and" no law or ruler found anywhere Eph 6:12, Col 1:16, 2:9-10,15-17
- f. "things present" present times, evil days, people, nations Gal 1:4, Rom 8:18
- g. "things to come" There is a world to come, too Eph 1:21, 3:21
- h. "height... depth" We know something now Job 11:7-9, 22:12, Eph 4:10, 3:18
- i. "any creature" Old creature, new creature, any created thing Rev 5:13, Phi 2:10
- j. "is able" not simply nothing will, but nothing is able to separate you. Impossible.
  - i. What God has joined together let no man... is now no man can put asunder.
- k. The inseparable position is in Christ Jesus our Lord → Rom 4:24, 5:21, 6:23, 7:25, 8:39
- I. How did we get into Christ? According to the dispensation of God's gospel of grace.
