Acts of the Apostles 1:16-26 Lesson 04

Replacing Judas

1. Acts 1:12-15 - In One Accord

- a. 1:13 The men here wrote the Hebrew epistles
- b. "one accord in prayer" There is no indication they were praying for the Spirit
- c. "Mary... and his brethren" See Matt 13:55, Mark 6:3, once unbelieving John 7:5
- d. Mary did not participate in Christ's redemptive work, she was his earthly mother

2. Acts 1:16-20 - The Death of Judas Fulfills Prophecy

- a. 1:16 David prophesied of Judas Ps 41:7-9,
- b. Judas plot to betray Matt 26:2-4, 14, 20-25, 45-56 multiple prophecies fulfilled
- c. Jesus knew who would betray him John 6:70-71, 13:2, 18-30, 18:4
- d. "he was numbered with us" Judah was the faithful tribe! Ps 55:12-14
 - i. Jesus was numbered with transgressors, Judas numbered among them
 - ii. None was lost save the son of perdition John 17:12
- e. The purchase of the potter's field Matthew 27:3-10 / Zech 11:12-13
- f. Did Judas hang himself, or fall off a cliff? Let God be true. God spoke both verses.
 - i. There was a great earthquake, perhaps he fell Matt 27:51
- g. "in the book of Psalms" Which spoke of Christ Ps 69:5,25; 109:9-15, Jn 15:25

3. Acts 1:21-26 – Ordaining the Twelfth Apostle

- a. They had to choose a replacement to be on twelve thrones Luke 22:28-30
- b. They were given authority to bind and loose Matt 18:18-20
- c. The twelfth apostle had to have followed him Matt 19:28
- d. To hold this office they had to be a witness of Christ's earthly ministry 1Jo 1:1
- e. The ministry began with the baptism of John (who did not preach the cross)
- f. The Twelve never saw Jesus in Heaven, Paul only saw Him in Heaven
- g. Matthias is confirmed by the Holy Spirit in Acts 2:4 and 1 Cor 15:5-8
- h. Barsabas may not be the same as Acts 4:36, 15:22, the names are different
- i. 1:24 They prayed to a Lord who leads them from heaven.
- j. 1:25 People disregard this verse because they cast lots, but Lev 16:8, Pro 16:33
