 - d. Daniel 9:24-27 Daniel prays for forgiveness, receives vision about last days
 - i. 'Seal up the vision and prophecy' Rev 10:7, 16:17
- 3. 'Day of the Lord' -Zephaniah 1:2-3, 14-18; 2:3 'day of the Lord'
 - i. Joel 1:15, 2:1, Amos 5:18
 - b. 'Hiding in the rocks' Isaiah 2:12-19 Revelation 6:14-17
 - c. 'Great earthquake' Zechariah 14:1-4 Lord stands on Zion (Rev 6:12, 11:13-19, 14:1)
 - i. Jeremiah 30:4-7 'time of Jacob's trouble'
- 4. 'Great Tribulation'
 - a. Matthew 24:21, 29-30 (Rev 6:12)
 - b. Daniel 12:1 time of trouble
- 5. Acts What happened? (Acts 2:16, 3:19, 8:1-3)
 - a. Revelation 12 'wonder in heaven'
 - b. Paul was saved the persecutor was saved!!! 1 Tim 1:15-16
 - c. 2 Cor 5:17-20 a new creature, reconciled to God
 - d. 1 Thess 1:10 delivered from wrath to come
 - e. 1 Thess 5:1-9 not appointed to wrath
- 6. Conclusion: The tribulation...
 - a. Comes upon Israel to purge them of sins 1 Peter 1:7; 4:17
 - b. Comes upon the world for rebelliousness 2 Thess 1:6-8
 - c. Ends with the Day of the Lord not the glorious appearing Titus 2:12
