Genesis 39 - Lesson 43

From Prosperity to Prison

1. Gen 39:1-6 - The LORD prospers Joseph

- a. "LORD was with Joseph" The brothers reject him, but God is with him Acts 7:8-10
- b. The word of the LORD tried Joseph is in Gen 39 Psalm 105:17-19
- c. God can prosper people Josh 1:8, Prov 3:5-6, Matt 6:33,
 - i. but also ... Prov 22:2, Ecc 9:11, Mt 5:45, Lk 12:15, Phil 4:12
- d. God is not a 'good luck' charm (his hand can destroy also) Lam 3:38
- e. God can do as he pleases to perform his purpose Eph 1:9,11
- f. People can prosper without God, and people can suffer with God.
- g. Why did God bless the Egyptian? ... "for Joseph's sake"

2. Gen 39:7-20 - Joseph's Temptation

- a. Abraham /sacrifice; Isaac /wells; Jacob /stones; Joseph /coats
- b. 39:7 "cast her eyes upon Joseph" Compare this to Judah/Tamar
- c. 39:9 "this great wickedness... against God" God is more terrible than his master
- d. Knowing the terror of the Lord, do you? 2 Cor 5:10-11, Matt 10:28
- e. 39:10-12 "or to be with her" Joseph distances himself from it 2 Ti 2:22, Psa 101:3
- f. Temptation to do evil is not from God, nor always from the devil Jam 1:12-16
- g. The lust of the flesh and eyes can destroy you from the inside out 1 John 2:15-16
- h. "will make a way to escape" the way must be walked beforehand 1 Co 10:13-14

3. Gen 39:21-23 - The LORD prospers Joseph

- a. Joseph does not say a word in his defense... like Jesus at his trial.
- b. "but the LORD was with Joseph" why? Because of Joseph? or... Rom 9:15-16
- c. How do you prosper in a prison? Joseph did because of the LORD.
- d. Why did the LORD prosper him? Gen 50:20
- e. Why does God prosper you? 1 Cor 16:2... for God's work to succeed.
